Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus called upon the Ministry of Fisheries and Livestock to step up efforts in deep-sea fishing and modernise livestock services, saying the country is missing out on enormous potential. The Chief Adviser said this while speaking at a meeting with Ministry officials at the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka yesterday. The Chief Adviser emphasised the importance of conducting proper surveys in the Bay of Bengal to identify viable deep-sea fishing zones, adding that Bangladesh could bring in expertise from countries like Japan or Thailand if necessary.

A high-level review meeting on the country's preparation to graduate from Least Developed Country (LDC) status to a developing country was held with Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus in the chair. The meeting was held at the Chief Adviser's Office in Tejgaon in Dhaka yesterday, Chief Adviser's Deputy Press Secretary Abul Kalam Azad Majumder said.

Finance Adviser Dr Salehuddin Ahmed asked the students to become laborious in life to achieve ultimate successes. The Adviser said this while addressing a function as the chief guest at the auditorium of the International Mother Language Institute in the capital yesterday. The Greater Noakhali Welfare Samity, Dhaka accorded a reception to the meritorious students and eminent personalities of Greater Noakhali at the event. Planning Adviser Dr Wahiduddin Mahmud spoke at the event as main discussant.

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Adviser Dr Asif Nazrul said, it would not be easy for the next government to ignore the people's expectation for reforms. The Adviser further noted that while Bangladesh has had several opportunities for systemic reform - particularly after 1971 and again in 1991- those chances were not properly utilized. The Adviser made the remarks while addressing a view-exchange meeting as the chief guest on the publication of the first draft of The Government Attorney Service Ordinance, 2025, held at the Judicial Administration Training Institute in the capital yesterday.

Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain urged an immediate, unconditional ceasefire in Gaza and accountability for crimes against Palestinians. The Adviser made the urges while addressing a high-level UN conference on the peaceful settlement of the Palestine question in New York the day before yesterday. The Adviser also emphasized the urgency to uphold international laws, humanitarian principles and the UN Charter.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said, there is no security threat centering August 5. The Adviser said this while speaking to journalists at his Ministry in Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday. Asked about the government measures regarding the attack on Hindu people at Gangachara in Rangpur district, he said, all involved in the attack will be exposed to justice.

Agriculture Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd.) Mohammad Jahangir Alam Chowdhury sought Chinese support in modernizing Bangladesh's agriculture sector through transferring farming technologies, establishment of modern cold storage facilities and imparting training to farmers and agricultural professionals. The Adviser said this when Chinese Ambassador to Bangladesh Yao Wen paid a courtesy call on him at his office in Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

Shipping Adviser Brigadier General (retd) Dr M Sakhawat Hossain sought the support of other International Maritime Organization (IMO) member states, including Djibouti for Bangladesh as the country is contesting as a Category-C member of the IMO Council for the 2026-27 term. The Adviser made the call when Djibouti's non-resident Ambassador to Bangladesh, Issei Abdillahi Assouh, met him at his Ministry in Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

National Consensus Commission Vice-Chairman Professor Ali Riaz said, there is a consensus on the gradual increase in women's representation in the Jatiya Sangsad to 100 seats. He made these remarks while briefing journalists after the second phase of discussions of commission with political parties at the Foreign Service Academy in the capital yesterday.

The Election Commission (EC) has approved the draft delimitation of parliamentary constituencies ahead of the 13th Jatiya Sangsad election. The technical committee has proposed to bring changes to 42 constituencies, of which the EC has approved minor changes to the boundaries of 39 constituencies. EC Commissioner Md. Anwarul Islam Sarkar briefed media at the EC building in the capital yesterday.

Bangladesh and Malaysian police have agreed to enhance mutual cooperation in combating transnational crimes. The agreement was made at a bilateral meeting between Bangladesh Police and Royal Malaysia Police held at the Police Headquarters in Dhaka yesterday, according to a press release of the Police Headquarters. Inspector General of Police of Bangladesh Police Baharul Alam led the Bangladesh delegation while Head of the Counter Terrorism Unit of the Royal Malaysia Police Azman Bin Abd Razak led the Malaysian seven members delegation.

Bangladesh Army and Nevada National Guard troops of the United States under United States Army Pacific Command completed their joint exercise dubbed as Tiger Lightning 2025, according to an ISPR statement yesterday. The ISPR also said, the week-long exercise, commenced on July 24, 2025, featured joint participation from the Bangladesh Army's Para-Commando Brigade and the United States' Nevada National Guard.

Bangladesh Bank issued a cyber-attack warning in banks and other financial institutions asking them to take precautionary measures. The Central Bank issued a notification in this regard yesterday.
