Newsbrief

Pakistan's Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Ishaq Dar arrived in Dhaka yesterday on a two-day official visit aimed at strengthening bilateral relations. The Pakistan's Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister landed at Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport on a special flight and was received by Foreign Secretary Asad Alam Siam, HSIA Executive Director Group Captain SM Ragib Samad confirmed it.

Commerce Adviser Sk Bashir Uddin along with Federal Commerce Minister of Pakistan Jam Kamal Khan visited Chattogram Port and expressed their satisfaction over the improvement and progress achieved by the country's Prime seaport. Commerce Adviser and his Pakistani counterpart made the visit the day before yesterday and witnessed extensively the overall operational activities and performance of the port. During the visit, Chairman of the Chattogram Port Authority Real Admiral S M Moniruzzaman briefed them on present state of the port including container and cargo handling, labor management, foreign investment and automation.

Home Affairs Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd.) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said that all necessary preparations are being undertaken for the upcoming national parliamentary election, in line with the timeline announced by Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus. The Adviser made these remarks after visiting the Bangladesh Agricultural Development Corporation's cold storage, central seed testing laboratory and vegetable seed processing center in the capital yesterday.

Health and Family Welfare Adviser Nurjahan Begum said, the interim government plans to build a separate 560-bed hospital in Rangpur city, specializing in kidney, cancer and heart diseases. The Adviser revealed this while talking to local journalists after visiting different departments of Rangpur Medical College Hospital yesterday.

Adviser to the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change Syeda Rizwana Hasan said, development must not come at the cost of destroying nature. The Adviser made these remarks while addressing the National Inter-College Cultural and Debate Competition- 2025 held at the National University in Gazipur yesterday.

Primary and Mass Education Adviser Bidhan Ranjon Ray Podder laid emphasis on providing moral education to students especially the primary level learners to build them as the worthy citizens of the country. The Adviser urged the guardians to help their children habituated with leading a moral life along with raising the sense of unity, fondness and discipline among them. The Adviser made these observations while exchanging views with the Headmasters and Primary education related officers at Shilpakola Academy in Kishoreganj yesterday as chief guest.


Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) AMM Nasir Uddin issued a stern warning against any attempts to seize control of polling centres during the upcoming 13th Jatiya Sangsad election, saying that such actions would lead to immediate cancellation of votes from the affected centres. The CEC told a view-exchange meeting with election officials at the Regional Public Administration Training Centre in Rajshahi yesterday.

Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam termed the recent outcome of tariff negotiations with the United States - securing a 20 percent tariff - as one of the interim government's major achievements. The Press Secretary said this at a roundtable discussion titled 'Bangladesh and Trump Tariffs: Economic Diplomacy in a World after Trade Regime' held at the Daily Star Bhaban in the capital's Farmgate area yesterday. Bangladesh Research Analysis and Information Network organized the event.

Attorney General and Chairman of the Bangladesh Bar Council Md. Asaduzzaman lauded the role of lawyers in the struggle of ousting the fascism from Bangladesh. The AG said this while addressing an extended meeting of the Bangladesh Bar Council at Multipurpose Hall Room of the bar council in Dhaka yesterday.

Bangladesh Ansar and VDP Director General Major General Abdul Motaleb Sajjad Mahmud said, about 650,000 Ansar members will be deployed at polling stations across the country in the upcoming national parliamentary elections. He said this at a function at Ansar Academy in Gazipur yesterday.
