## Newsbrief

Chief Adviser and Chairman of the National Consensus Commission Professor Muhammad Yunus called for advancing reform activities quickly with the goal of holding the national elections in between December 2025 and June 2026. He made this call at a meeting with two members of the Consensus Commission at the State Guest House Jamuna yesterday. National Consensus Commission Vice-Chairman Professor Ali Riaz and its member Dr. Badiul Alam Majumder joined the meeting.

Chief Justice Syed Refaat Ahmed said, the country's judiciary has embarked on a new journey after the July mass uprising, and the people will regain their lost trust in the judiciary. The Chief Justice said this while addressing a regional seminar titled 'Judicial Independence and Efficiency' organised jointly by Supreme Court and the United Nations Development Programme at a hotel in Khulna yesterday.

Romania accepted Dhaka's proposal of arranging alternative mechanisms for the issuance of visas to the Bangladeshi nationals. This was revealed when Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain held a meeting with Romanian Foreign Minister Emil Hurezeanu on the sidelines of the 'Antalya Diplomacy Forum 2025' in Antalya, Türkiye yesterday. The Romanian Minister also proposed to explore the possibilities of signing a bilateral instrument on migration and mobility to ensure legal migration between the two countries and the Bangladeshi side concurred.

Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain said that Dhaka needs a reliable partner in aerospace technology and it would be a win-win situation for both Bangladesh and Türkiye if they cooperate with each other. He made the remark when holding a meeting along with Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md. Mahfuz Alam with President & CEO of 'Turkish Aerospace', Mehmet Demiroğlu on the sidelines of the 'Antalya Diplomacy Forum 2025' in Antalya, Türkiye, according to a Foreign Ministry's press release yesterday. During the meeting, both sides reached a consensus to explore the options for investment in Bangladesh and for transfer of related technologies for human resource development.

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Division Adviser Dr. Asif Nazrul said, the interim government will resolve the longstanding crises over judges' shortage and logistics. The Adviser said this while talking to newsmen after inspecting the land acquired for the Chief Judicial Court of Bandarban yesterday.

Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md. Mahfuz Alam invited Turkish investors to come up with investment in Bangladesh economic zones as Turkish Trade Minister Professor Ömer Bolat called on him on the sidelines of the "Antalya Diplomacy Forum-2025" in Türkiye. Important aspects of bilateral trade and economic relations between Türkiye and Bangladesh were discussed at their meeting on Friday, according to an official press release yesterday.

Religious Affairs Adviser Dr. AFM Khalid Hossain said, imams and khatibs have opportunity to raise their voices against dowry in various forums and they should utilise the scope. The Adviser said this while exchanging views with the registrars of Muslim Nikah at LGED Bhaban in Chattogram yesterday. Bangladesh Muslim Nikah Registrar Forum organised the meeting on preventing child marriage.

Social Welfare, Women and Children Affairs Adviser Sharmeen S Murshid said, a new Bangladesh has emerged driven by the energy and determination of the youth in standing up against oppression, injustice and corruption under the previous fascist regime. She made these remarks while speaking as the chief guest at the Eid Reunion and New Year Festival-2025, organized by the Women Entrepreneurs Association at the Cosmopolitan Club in the capital's Baridhara yesterday.

Chief of Army Staff General Waker-Uz-Zaman returned home yesterday following official visits to Russia and Croatia, according to a statement on the verified Facebook page of the Bangladesh Army.

Bangladesh Navy ship 'BNS Somudra Avijan' carrying the second phase of humanitarian assistance items for the earthquake-affected people of Myanmar arrived in Yangon. Bangladesh Ambassador to Myanmar Dr. M Monwar Hossain handed over the relief materials to the Chief Minister of the Yangon Region, U Soe Thein, at a ceremony at the MITT jetty, Yangon yesterday.

Dengue claimed two more lives and sent 22 people to hospitals across the country in the 24 hours till Saturday morning, according to the Directorate General of Health Services yesterday.
