Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus called for accelerating the integrated development of roads, railways, airways and waterways while keeping nature, the environment and rivers free from negative impacts. The Chief Adviser made the call at an inter-ministerial meeting on the marginal evaluation and strategic planning of the 'Central Integrated Multimodal Transport Sector Master Plan of Bangladesh' at the State Guest House Jamuna, according to a press release of Chief Adviser's Press Wing said yesterday.

Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain reaffirmed Bangladesh's firm solidarity with Qatar against any threat to its security and sovereignty. The Adviser made the assurance during a bilateral meeting with Qatari State Minister for Foreign Affairs Sultan bin Saad bin Sultan Al Muraikhi on the sidelines of the ongoing 21st IISS Manama Dialogue in Bahrain the day before yesterday, according to a Foreign Ministry's press release said yesterday.

Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain has underscored the importance of peace and stability in the Middle East. The Adviser remarked during a bilateral meeting with Bahraini Foreign Minister Dr Abdullatif bin Rashid Alzayani on the sidelines of the ongoing 21st IISS Manama Dialogue in Bahrain the day before yesterday, according to a Foreign Ministry's press release yesterday.

Land Adviser Ali Imam Majumdar said, survey and settlement are the foundation of ensuring land services. The Adviser said these at the inauguration ceremony of the '141st Survey and Settlement Training Course' for BCS cadre and Judicial Service officers at the meeting room of Karim Jute Mills Limited in Demra, Dhaka yesterday. The training course was organized by the Department of Land Records and Survey.

Energy Affairs Adviser Dr Muhammad Fouzul Kabir Khan said, a national review committee found 'massive irregularities' in deals including ones with foreign companies by the past regime under Quick Enhancement of Electricity and Energy Supply (Special Provision) Act 2010. The Adviser told reporters after receiving the report of the National Review Committee headed by a retired High Court judge.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan said that constructing environment-friendly buildings is no longer a choice, but a necessity. The Adviser made the remark while speaking as the chief guest at a workshop on 'Green Building', organized by the Department of Environment in the capital's Agargaon yesterday.

Adviser of the Ministry of Water Resources and the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change Syeda Rizwana Hasan has underscored the urgent need for integrated land and water management to protect the Chalan Beel, one of country's largest water bodies. The Adviser said this while speaking as the chief guest at the inception workshop of a project titled 'Integrated Management of Land and Water Resources and Feasibility Study on Quality of Life for the Restoration of Chalan Beel', at Pani Bhaban in the capital yesterday.

Primary and Mass Education Adviser Professor Dr Bidhan Ranjan Roy Podder said that parents and teachers must be aware to improve the quality of education in the haor regions. The Adviser made the remark while speaking as the chief guest at an exchange of views meeting on the role of stakeholders in improving the quality of primary education at the Hason Raja Auditorium of Sunamganj Primary Teachers' Training Institute in Sunamganj yesterday. The Adviser also said that teachers should be conscious of children's health, alongside ensuring they have opportunities for play and physical development.




