Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus urged the countrymen to actively participate in the upcoming national election and referendum, saying that this poll will decide the character, structure and direction of progress of the new Bangladesh. The Chief Adviser made the urges while addressing the nation yesterday on the occasion of the Victory Day 2025. Chief Adviser said, the government is extending all necessary cooperation to ensure treatment for ailing BNP Chairperson Begum Khaleda Zia. The Chief Adviser also issued a stern warning, saying that no one involved in the recent attack on Sharif Osman Hadi, a frontline fighter of the July uprising and spokesperson of the Inqilab Mancha, will be spared.

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Adviser Professor Asif Nazrul said, December 16 is Bangladesh's Victory Day, which is the greatest day for the people of the country. The Adviser made the remarks while speaking to journalists after paying tributes at the National Memorial premises in Savar yesterday. The Adviser also said, it was the spirit of December 16 that enabled the nation to create an opportunity to rebuild Bangladesh through the historic July mass uprising.

LGRD and Cooperatives and Housing and Public Works Adviser Adilur Rahman Khan said, the people of Bangladesh want an end to border killings. The Adviser also said, a most heinous situation like border killings continues along Bangladesh border, a reality the country is placing before the conscience of the world. The Adviser made the remarks at the unveiling ceremony of the nameplate of 'Felani Avenue', naming the road from Gulshan-2 roundabout to Pragati Sarani in memory of Felani, the teenage girl killed by BSF gunfire at the border. Dhaka North City Corporation organized the event at the Gulshan-2 roundabout yesterday.

Religious Affairs Adviser Dr. A F M Khalid Hossain said that the Great Liberation War was an armed protest against oppression and deprivation. The Adviser made the remarks while addressing as the chief guest the ceremony marking the two-decade anniversary of Al-Iman Adarsha Mohila Alim Madrasah and the unveiling ceremony of Al-Iman commemorative-2 at Uttar Jhapuya of Maheshkhali upazila in Cox's Bazar yesterday. Praying for eternal peace of the martyrs of the Liberation War, the Adviser said the nation has stepped into the 55th year of victory.

The government has formulated a policy on issuing firearm licences and appointing armed retainers for politically important persons and candidates contesting the election ahead of the 13th National Parliamentary Election scheduled for February 12. Ministry of Home Affairs issued the formulation yesterday.

The Great Victory Day was celebrated with due honour and various programmes at the Bangladesh Embassy in Riyadh yesterday, highlighting the role of expatriates in safeguarding democracy and advancing national progress. Bangladesh Ambassador to Saudi Arabia Md. Delwar Hossain paid tribute to the valiant freedom fighters who laid down their lives for the country's independence and sovereignty, as well as those who were martyred during the July-August uprising against fascism.

The European Union has formally announced the deployment of an EU Election Observation Mission to Bangladesh for the February 2026 parliamentary polls, appointing Member of the European Parliament Ivars Ijabs as Chief Observer. The decision was taken in response to a formal invitation from the Bangladeshi authorities, according to an EU press release issued yesterday.

The Rapid Action Battalion (RAB) has recovered firearms and ammunition used in the shooting of Sharif Osman Hadi, Spokesperson of Inqilab Moncho and a parliamentary candidate for the Dhaka-8 constituency, from Narsingdi. RAB also detained a man identified as Md. Faisal, 25, in connection with the incident. According to Wing Commander MZM Intekhab Chowdhury, Director of RAB's Legal and Media Wing, the recovery was made yesterday.
