Newsbrief

Law Adviser Dr Asif Nazrul lauded the heroic role of the country's youth during the July uprising saying that they have always been in the front row whenever there was a justice and democracy movement in the country. The Adviser said this while inaugurating the Sixth Jessup Workshop at the BRAC University Campus in the capital yesterday.

Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain said, the Indian government is currently examining the matter of extraditing Sheikh Hasina. The Adviser told journalists at the Circuit House in Rangpur yesterday upon arriving for a four-day visit. The Adviser also said, he had no information regarding BNP's Acting Chairman Tarique Rahman's return.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury has stressed the need for specialized training, particularly in earthquake preparedness, alongside recalling the indispensable role of volunteers in national service and disaster response. The Adviser also said that laws are enacted to ensure benefits and greater advantages for the people.

The Adviser made the remarks while opening the programme marking the International Volunteer Day 2025, organized by the Fire Service and Civil Defence at its Multipurpose Training Ground in Rupganj, Narayanganj yesterday.

Industries Adviser Adilur Rahman Khan said, the country will not import sugar if adequate stocks are available in domestic warehouses. The Adviser made the remarks while addressing the inaugural ceremony of the 88th sugarcane crushing season of Carew & Company (Bangladesh) Ltd in Darshana of Dhaka yesterday.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change and Water Resources Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan called for strengthening regional cooperation on water governance in South Asia, stressing water justice, river rights, disaster preparedness and equitable benefit sharing among countries of the Hindu Kush Himalayan region. The Adviser made the call while speaking virtually from Dhaka at the Sub-regional Workshop on Water and Climate Resilience in the HK: Advancing SDG 2030 Agenda through Science and Cooperation, held in Kathmandu, Nepal yesterday.

Labour and Employment Ministry Adviser Brig Gen (Retd.) Dr M Sakhawat Hussain said ratifying three International Labour Organization (ILO) conventions at the same time is a historic decision to strengthen workers' rights and ensure workplace safety in the country. The Adviser said this while speaking a celebration event, held on Thursday at the Foreign Service Academy to commemorate the landmark decision, according to an official release yesterday. The event jointly organized by the Ministry of Labour and Employment and ILO Bangladesh. The achievement is not merely a legal milestone but a clear message to the world that the interim government is committed to upholding workers' dignity, safety and rights, the Adviser added.

Religious Affairs Adviser Dr AFM Khalid Hossain said that patriots never launder the country's money abroad. The Adviser also said that after 54 years of the country's independence, the Alem-Ulama now have the opportunity to come to power and if they make any mistake this time, they may have to wait another 54 years. The Adviser said this while speaking at the International Qirat Conference, organized by Cumilla Al Quran Academy, at Cumilla Central Eidgah Maidan the day before yesterday.

Commerce, Textile and Jute and Civil Aviation and Tourism Adviser Sk. Bashir Uddin said that no misguided or emotion-driven decisions will be made in the textile sector, noting that such decisions had affected the jute industry in the past. The Adviser made the remarks on Thursday while addressing a seminar as the chief guest at the Jute Diversification Promotion Centre in Dhaka, marking National Textile Day 2025. The seminar was held under the theme, 'Resilience and Reinvention: Creating Skilled Professionals for the Textile and Apparel Sector of Bangladesh.'

The air ambulance arranged for former Prime Minister and BNP Chairperson Begum Khaleda Zia's medical transfer to London will come from Germany under a Qatar government facilitated arrangement. Public Relations Officer of the Qatar Embassy in Dhaka Asadur Rahman Asad told BSS yesterday.

Special doa was offered at all mosques across the country after Jummah prayers yesterday, seeking speedy recovery of BNP Chairperson Begum Khaleda Zia, three-time former Prime Minister and wife of Shaheed President Ziaur Rahman. In addition, temples, churches, pagodas and all other places of worship are holding prayers for her recovery according to their respective religious traditions and practices.

A vessel carrying 60,950 metric tonnes of wheat from the United States has reached the outer anchorage of Chattogram Port under cash purchase agreement No. G2G-01, signed between the governments of Bangladesh and the United States. Bangladesh has begun importing wheat from the US under a government-to-government (G2G) arrangement, according to a PID handout said yesterday.

The Government of Bangladesh, Embassy of Ukraine, Embassy of Sweden and United Nations World Food Programme (WFP) have jointly marked the handover of 3,000 metric tonnes of sunflower oil for Rohingya refugees under the Grain from Ukraine initiative. This contribution will support the Rohingya response led by the government with the support of WFP and other humanitarian partners, according to a WFP release said yesterday.
