Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus said, the United Nations (UN) must continue to evolve and adapt to fulfill collective aspiration for peace and multilateralism. The Chief Adviser said this in a message yesterday marking the United Nations Day on October 24, which marks the 80th founding anniversary of the UN. This is an occasion for the international community to renew its pledge to build a world free from fear and want and rejuvenate the spirit of multilateralism and consensus-building that the UN embodies, the Chief Adviser added. On the occasion, the Chief Adviser wished all member states, partners in the UN System and other stakeholders a happy 'United Nations Day'.

Shipping and Labour and Employment Adviser Brigadier General (Retd) Dr M. Sakhawat Hussain said, the historic paddle steamer PS Masud is set to become a unique blend of heritage and river-centric tourism in the country. The Adviser made the remarks while joining an experimental voyage of PS Masud on the Dhaka-Munshiganj route from Sadarghat, according to an official handout yesterday. After extensive maintenance and renovation, the traditional vessel has returned with a fresh look, now equipped with modern facilities and enhanced safety features, the Adviser added.

Social Welfare and Women and Children Affairs Adviser Sharmeen S Murshid said that physical and mental well-being must be prioritized to build a new and prosperous Bangladesh. Highlighting the role of youth the Adviser said, the young people must take responsibility for promoting nutrition and mental health to ensure the emergence of a healthy generation. She also urged the youth to uphold unity, respect and inclusiveness, saying the young generation must prepare for social work to lead the country forward. The Adviser made these remarks while inaugurating the two-day National Nutrition and Wellness Summit at the Department of Social Services auditorium at Agargaon in Dhaka yesterday.

Chittagong Hill Tracts (CHT) Affairs Adviser Supradip Chakma said, the government will digitalize 100 educational institutions in CHT by November this year. The Adviser also stressed that quality education is highly essential for sustainable development in the CHT. The Adviser made the remarks while addressing the 'Kathin Chibar Dan-2025', held at the Shakyamuni Buddhist Monastery in the capital yesterday.

Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam has expressed hope that the upcoming election, scheduled for February next year, will be a milestone in the democratic history of the nation. The Press Secretary made the remarks while speaking to journalists after visiting the July Memorial, built in memory of the martyrs of the July Mass Uprising of 2024, at Nabhanga Park in Magura the day before yesterday.

Bangladesh has strongly condemned the recent approval by the Israeli Knesset of draft laws aimed at imposing so-called 'Israeli sovereignty' over the occupied territories in the West Bank of the State of Palestine. The Foreign Ministry said this in a statement yesterday. It said that Israel continued its unlawful occupation through the expansion of illegal settlements in the West Bank, in blatant violation of international law, the UN Charter and relevant UN Security Council resolutions.

Nominee for the post of United States Ambassador to Bangladesh Brent Christensen has expressed his intent to strengthen cooperation with Bangladesh's both current Interim and its future democratically elected government to further advance the Dhaka-Washington partnership. He told the Senate Committee on Foreign Relations in his opening statement during his nomination hearing in Washington DC the day before yesterday.

A total of 309 Bangladeshi nationals who had been staying irregularly in Libya were repatriated to Bangladesh through a special chartered flight arranged with the cooperation of the Government of Libya, the International Organization for Migration (IOM) and the Bangladesh Embassy in Tripoli. Ministry of Foreign Affairs said this in a press release yesterday.

Major General Abdul Motaleb Sazzad Mahmud, Director General (DG) of Ansar and VDP said, Bangladesh Ansar and Village Defence Party (Ansar-VDP) is fully prepared ahead of the 13th National Parliamentary Election, with 600,000 Ansar members set to be deployed across the country. The DG said this while speaking at the Ansar and VDP headquarters in Dhaka the day before yesterday.
