Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus stressed presenting the true history of the Liberation War impartially through the activities of the Ministry of Liberation War. The Chief Adviser said this at a meeting held at the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka yesterday.

National Consensus Commission Vice-Chairman Professor Ali Riaz said, the political parties agree to ensure that the declaration of a state of emergency should not be used politically under any circumstances. He told this at a media briefing after the end of the 10th day of the second phase of the talks of the commission with political parties at Foreign Service Academy yesterday.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury has warned all against any sort of mob violence in the country. The Home Adviser said this while talking to journalists after visiting the Industrial Police Headquarters and Uttara Purba Police Station in the capital the day before yesterday.

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Adviser Dr Asif Nazrul said that the trial of the killers of July Uprising must be held before the upcoming national elections. The Adviser made the remarks while delivering his speech of welcome at an event held prior to screening the premiere show of the documentary 'Shraban Bidroho' at the National Museum auditorium in the capital's Shahbagh yesterday.

Food Adviser Ali Imam Majumder said, Bangladesh must ensure food safety to enter into the global market for export. Bangladesh has huge scope for food export, but it cannot utilize the opportunity as it could not ensure safe food everywhere, he said. The Adviser said this while speaking at a seminar title 'Modern Food Safety System in Bangladesh' organized by Bangladesh Food Safety Authority at pan Pacific Sonargaon Hotel in the capital yesterday.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan said, to transform the Bangladesh Climate Change Trust (BCCT) into an efficient, self-reliant, and future-ready institution, a 10-year strategic plan will be formulated with expert guidance. The Adviser made the announcement while speaking as the chief guest at a stakeholder meeting with officials and staff at the BCCT office in Mohakhali, Dhaka yesterday. The Environment Adviser also said, the Climate Change Trust Act 2010 will be amended and the operational guidelines will be updated to make those more relevant to current needs.

Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md. Mahfuj Alam called for following the spirit of July mass uprising in building a democratic state where civil rights of all will be protected. The Adviser said this at the premiere show of the documentary 'Shraban Bidroho', made on the July Uprising, at the main auditorium of the Bangladesh National Museum in Shahbagh yesterday. At the premiere show of the documentary event, Housing and Public Works Adviser Adilur Rahman Khan said, Fascist forces are trying to come back. But their conspiracy must be resisted. He called upon everyone to be vocal so that fascism can never raise its head again. At the same event, Cultural Affairs Adviser Mostofa Sarwar Farooki said, if there is a political consensus, fascism will not be able to come back. Shaheed Abu Sayeed's father Maqbul Hossain and martyred journalist Tahir Zaman Priyo's mother Shamsi Ara Zaman also spoke at the event with Information and Broadcasting Secretary Mahbuba Farzana in the chair.

Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives Adviser Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuyain unveiled the nameplates of 'Shaheed Junaid Chattar' and 'Shaheed Shahariar Khan Anas Road' at a ceremony in the capital's Gendaria area yesterday. At the ceremony the Adviser said, their blood will not go in vain. Government is committed to building Bangladesh they dreamed of, which was resulted from their unyielding patriotism and sacrifice.

Press Secretary to the Chief Adviser Shafiqul Alam said that the inflation rate in Bangladesh has been declining speedily thanks to the prudent policies and strategies of the interim government. He also expressed his optimism that inflation would come down further in the coming months. The Press Secretary shared this information through a post on his verified Facebook page yesterday.

Special Assistant to the Chief Adviser Faiz Ahmed Tayyab said, different changes brought by the interim government in telecommunication sector have hurt the interest of all wrong-doers and corrupt people of the past period. He said this while addressing a press conference at the Foreign Service Academy in the capital yesterday.


