Newsbrief

Chief of Army Staff General Waker-uz-Zaman, accompanied by his spouse, paid a courtesy call on President Mohammed Shahabuddin at Bangabhaban yesterday on the occasion of the holy Eid-ul-Azha. During the meeting, they exchanged Eid greetings and conveyed best wishes for mutual well-being, according to the Bangladesh Army.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus offered the holy Eid-ul-Azha prayers at the National Eidgah yesterday. The Chief Adviser was accompanied by the Chief Justice, judges of the Supreme Court and High Court divisions, members of the Council of Advisers, leaders of various political parties, senior government officials and diplomats of various Muslim countries stationed in Dhaka, along with thousands of Muslim devotees.

Chief of Army Staff General Waker-Uz-Zaman and Chief of the Navy Staff Admiral M Nazmul Hassan with their spouses called on the Chief Adviser on the occasion of the holy Eid-ul-Azha at the State Guest House Jamuna, Chief Adviser's Deputy Press Secretary Abul Kalam Azad Majumder told this to reporters yesterday.

Home Affairs Adviser Lt. Gen. (Retd.) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury exchanged Eid-ul-Azha greetings with members of various law enforcement agencies at Rajarbagh Police Lines in the capital yesterday. Later, the Adviser visited Bangladesh Ansar and Village Defense Force, Fire Service and Civil Defense Department, Bangladesh Border Guard, Mirpur Public Order Management and Bangladesh Coast Guard headquarters. During his visit, he exchanged Eid greetings with members of various forces, inquired about them.

Sacrificial waste management activities started simultaneously in 75 wards of Dhaka South City Corporation (DSCC) yesterday. Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives Adviser Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuyain inspected the Secondary Transfer Station adjacent to Kalabagan Shishu Park to see the rapid removal of sacrificial waste. During the inspection, the Adviser said, cleaning sacrificial waste in the city is a big challenge.

LGRD and Co-operatives Adviser Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuyain said, not animal, but pride, jealousy and injustice should be sacrificed. The Adviser said this at his verified Facebook page yesterday.

Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md. Mahfuj Alam offered Eid-ul-Azha prayers at a mosque on Hair Road in the capital yesterday. After the Eid prayers, he exchanged Eid greetings with devotees. The Adviser prayed for the eternal peace of the departed souls of those who were martyred in the July uprising and sought early recovery of those who were injured during the mass upsurge. The Adviser also sought divine blessings for peace and progress of Bangladesh and welfare of the people as well as the Muslim Ummah.

Dhaka North and South City Corporations have adopted a plan to remove the waste of sacrificial animals within 12 hours and about 20,267 cleaning workers were kept ready for this. Dhaka South City Corporation (DSCC) Administrator Md. Shahjahan Mia told reporters yesterday that a supervisory council has been formed comprising high-level officials of DSCC to supervise the sacrificial animal markets and related matters including waste management activities generated by sacrificial animals in the DSCC area.
