Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus expressed dissatisfaction over the stalling of the two surface water projects for long 10 years and said over extraction of groundwater is putting the country's environment at grave risk. The Chief Adviser told a meeting with the authorities concerned to know the progress of the 'Water Treatment Plant Construction Project Phase-3' and the 'Meghna River Protection Master Plan Project'. The meeting was held at the State Guest House Jamuna in the capital yesterday.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus invited Kuwaiti investors to explore opportunities in Bangladesh's Special Economic Zones and the upcoming Bangladesh Investment Summit to be held on 7-9 April in Dhaka. The Chief Adviser told new Kuwait Ambassador to Dhaka Ali Tunyan Abdul Wahab Hamadah as he called on the Chief Adviser at the State Guest House Jamuna yesterday. During the meeting, they renewed their commitment to strengthening diplomatic, trade, and economic ties, with a focus on investment, energy, food security and migrant welfare.

Foreign Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain and Pakistani Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Mohammad Ishaq Dar held meeting in Jeddha. The meeting took place in a cordial environment, reflecting the fraternal sentiments from both sides, according to a press release of Pakistan High Commission in Dhaka yesterday. During the meeting, both the dignitaries expressed satisfaction over the upward trajectory of bilateral relations and agreed to enhance bilateral cooperation in all areas of mutual interest, added the release.

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Adviser Dr. Asif Nazrul categorically said that the government was firm to prevent violence against women, torture and anarchic activities in the country. The Adviser said this at a media briefing following law and order meeting at his Ministry in presence of Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus yesterday.

Home Adviser Lt. Gen. (Retd) Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said that there is no room for the rapists in the country. The Adviser told a media briefing on law and order at the law ministry conference room at Secretariat yesterday. Earlier, the Home Adviser said that the government will ensure trial of the miscreants who were involved in the recent rape incidents. The Adviser made this comment as he visited the minor child, who was gang raped in Magura, at the Combine Military Hospital in the capital yesterday.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan stressed the need for increasing the use of jute products to reduce the harmful effects of polythene. The Adviser said, expanding the use of jute products is essential for ensuring sustainable development. The Adviser said this while visiting stalls at the 'Multipurpose Jute Product Fair & Handloom Textile Fair 2025' organized by the Jute Diversification Promotion Center in the capital's Farmgate yesterday. The fair aims to popularize eco-friendly and sustainable jute products.

Information and Broadcasting Adviser Mahfuz Alam said, the government has taken a zero tolerance policy against social instability or any form of anarchy. The Adviser said this while speaking at a media briefing on law and order at the law Ministry conference room at the Secretariat yesterday.
