Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus said that Malaysia's experience in hosting Rohingya refugees along with its leadership position in ASEAN can come in handy to push for a comprehensive regional solution to the longstanding refugee crisis. The Chief Adviser told the Malaysian National News Agency (Bernama) in a special interview before concluding his official visit to Malaysia recently.

Finance Adviser Dr Salehuddin Ahmed said, the suicide in Rajshahi over debt is unfortunate and it should be investigated with utmost importance. The Adviser said this while talking to reporters after attending the board meeting at the Bangladesh Public Administration Training Centre in Dhaka yesterday.

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Adviser Dr Asif Nazrul said that people used to go abroad for treatment when they felt helpless. The Adviser also said, the physicians of Bangladesh have the ability of giving required treatments that they proved during the Corona period. The Adviser said these at the annual general meeting of the newly elected executive committee of the Bangladesh Private Hospital, Clinic and Diagnostic Owners Association at Shaheed Abu Sayed International Convention Center in the capital yesterday.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury (Retd.) said that the upcoming general election will be held in February in line with the announcement made the Chief Adviser. The Home Adviser made these statements while distributing anti-polythene leaflets at the Krishi Market area in Mohammadpur yesterday, part of an ongoing campaign to raise awareness about the dangers of illegal polythene usage.


