Newsbrief

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan stressed on the critical role of women alongside men in promoting environmental conservation and climate resilience. The Adviser urged all to work with utmost sincerity for positive change in the society and extend support to disadvantaged individuals. The Adviser also urged all organisations like the Inner Wheel to continue their inspiring works through service and friendship, setting impactful examples for society to follow.

BNP Secretary General Mirza Fakhru Islam Alamgir called upon the country's young generation to focus on sports along with education and stay away from drug abuse. The BNP Secretary General said this while inaugurating Zia Inter-Thana Football Tournament at the Pallabi City Club ground in Mirpur yesterday. Awami League has destroyed all the institutions of the country in the last 15 years as the sports arena is a big example of that, the BNP Secretary General added.

Fact checking body Rumor Scanner in an investigation debunked a video circulated on social media and Indian media claiming that a Hindu house in Bishnupur, Bagerhat was set on fire, In a report published on its website yesterday. In addition, Indian media outlet News18 Bangla, citing X Post, circulated the same video and claimed in their news that minorities were affected by the conflict between the two sides of BNP. The investigation of the Rumor Scanner team revealed that the circulated video is not a scene of arson in the houses of Hindus in Bishnupur, Bagerhat, but rather a scene of arson in the houses due to the dispute between the two parties over the establishment of dominance and the formation of the Union BNP committee. The houses that were set on fire in this incident belong to Muslims.

Former Land Minister Saifuzzaman Chowdhury Javed and his wife Rukhmila Zaman have 580 apartments in the UK, the UAE and the USA. A team of the Anti Corruption Commission (ACC) started investigation suspecting that the former Lawmaker could have more illegal assets at home and abroad, according to a press release yesterday. According to ACC sources, in response to the ACC's application the court ordered attachment and freeze of those assets and money, laundered abroad by Javed and prevent those from transferring to others.

Shaheed Abu Sayeed Foundation (SASF) distributed blankets among the cold-stricken poor people in a function held on Kuthipara Government Primary School ground in Pirgachha upazila on January 9. Pirgachha Upazila Nirbahi Officer Nazmul Haque Suman attended the programme as the chief guest and distributed blankets to 250 helpless and poor cold-stricken people of different riverine char areas of the upazila. Shaheed Abu Sayeed Foundation President and Abu Sayeed's brother Md. Ramzan Ali presided over the function.
