Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus returned home yesterday, wrapping up his four-day official tour to London. Chief Adviser's Senior Assistant Press Secretary Foyez Ahammad said this to newsmen.

Home Affairs Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd.) Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said, all preparations of the law enforcement agencies required to ensure security during the polls have already been taken. The Adviser said this while replying to a question after visiting the RAB-1 headquarters in the capital's Uttara area yesterday. The Home Adviser said that the law and order in the country has improved in the last 11 months.

Home Affairs Adviser Lieutenant (Retd.) General Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said, the police will no longer have lethal or heavy weapons. The Adviser said this after visiting the offices of the Armed Police Battalion in Dhaka yesterday.

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Adviser Dr Asif Nazrul said, making alternative dispute resolution (ADR) methods mandatory is essential to address the persistent and overwhelming backlog of cases. The Ministry is taking prompt and decisive steps to implement this initiative, he said. The Adviser made this remark while presiding over a view-exchange meeting organized on the draft of the Legal Aid Act (Amendment) Ordinance 2025 at the conference room of the National Legal Aid Services Organization yesterday.

Local Government Rural Development (LGRD) and Cooperatives Adviser Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuyain said, the way of victory for pro-Bangladesh people becomes easier. The Adviser said this in a post on his verified Facebook account the day before yesterday after a meeting between Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus and BNP's Acting Chairman Tarique Rahman in London.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan announced that a comprehensive master plan would be developed to promote eco-friendly tourism in Jaflong and other tourist destinations in Sylhet. Talking to journalists after visiting the Jaflong area, the Adviser said the master plan will prioritise creating alternative livelihood opportunities for workers currently involved in stone extraction. Power, Energy and Mineral Resources, and Environment, Forest and Climate Change will work in coordination to implement this plan.


Information and Broadcasting Adviser Mahfuj Alam expressed deep shock at the death of maintenance engineer Mohammad Azim Uddin of directorate of Mass Communication. The Adviser said this in a condolence message yesterday. The Adviser also prayed for eternal peace of the departed soul and conveyed profound sympathy to the bereaved family. Information Secretary Mahbuba Farzana also condoled his death.

One death and 169 fresh cases were reported from dengue in the last 24 hours till Saturday, according the Directorate General of Health Services in a handout yesterday.




