**Newsbrief**

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus's participation in the 80th United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) underscored Bangladesh's role as a responsible global actor committed to democratic governance, humanitarian solidarity and constructive international cooperation, Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam said. The Press Secretary made the remarks in a post shared in his verified Facebook account, highlighting the CA's UNGA tour achievements.

Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md. Mahfuj Alam expressed deep shock and sorrow over the death of Language Movement veteran Ahmed Rafiq. In a condolence message yesterday, the Adviser prayed for eternal peace of the departed soul and conveyed profound sympathy to the bereaved family. His work and ideals will remain a source of inspiration for future generations, the Adviser added.

Bangladesh deeply condemned the interception of the Global Sumud Flotilla in the international water, which was carrying humanitarian assistance for the people of Gaza, by the Israeli occupying forces. Foreign Ministry issued a statement in this regard yesterday. Bangladesh called upon the immediate and unconditional release of all detained humanitarian aid workers and activists and to guarantee their safety and well-being. Bangladesh further urged Israel to end its illegal occupation of Gaza and the West Bank, respect international humanitarian law and immediately cease its genocidal war and humanitarian blockade in Gaza.

Condolences continued to pour in following the death of Language Movement veteran Ahmed Rafiq. Advisers to the Interim Government yesterday expressed deep sorrow and grief at his passing. In separate condolence messages, Cultural Affairs Adviser Mostofa Sarwar Farooki and Social Welfare and Women and Children Affairs Adviser Sharmeen Soneya Murshid prayed for eternal peace of the departed soul and conveyed profound sympathy to the bereaved family.

Attorney General Md. Asaduzzaman said, there is no legal barrier to implementing the July Charter and that it can proceed in line with the recommendations of the National Consensus Commission. The Attorney General made the remarks while talking to journalists following a view-exchange meeting with local media representatives at the Johan Dream Valley Park Auditorium in Jhenaidah yesterday.

Chief Adviser's Special Assistant on Ministry of Posts, Telecommunications and Information Technology Faiz Ahmad Taiyeb today expressed deep shock and sorrow over the death of Language Movement veteran Ahmed Rafiq.
