Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus promised the Commission of Enquiry on Enforced Disappearances to provide all possible support to them to identify the people responsible for enforced disappearance between 2009 and 2024 and hold them accountable. The Chief Adviser told the Commission members during a meeting, attended by several Advisers and key officials, at the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka yesterday.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan said, wildlife hunting and trafficking must be checked to protect biodiversity. The Adviser called for conservation of all wildlife including tigers and elephants, saying deforestation should be stopped to protect existing forests. The Adviser said this while speaking as the chief guest at the national closing ceremony of the 'Wildlife Olympiad' held at Viqarunnisa Noon School and College in Dhaka yesterday.

The government is giving importance on renewable energy as power consumption has been increased rapidly across the country. Power, Energy and Mineral Resources Adviser Muhammad Fouzul Kabir Khan said this while inaugurating first Solar Energy Lab with ESS facilities in Bangladesh at United International University (UIU) premises yesterday.

Adviser to the interim government Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuyain said, the law enforcers would take stern action if any organization linked to mass-killing tries to hold any political programme. The Adviser gave this warning in a post from his verified Facebook account yesterday.

Adviser to the Ministry of Religious Affairs Dr. A F M Khalid Hossain today opined that the country's overall development was not possible without communal harmony. The Adviser said while addressing as the chief guest at a view exchange meeting with Islamic Scholars in Khulna.

Shipping Adviser Brigadier General (retd) Dr. M Sakhawat Hussain said, forming an independent police commission is a must to build humane police. The Member of the Police Commission should be limited maximum five and an officer from the judiciary can be appointed as its Head, the Adviser opined. The Adviser said this while addressing as the chief guest a seminar titled "Police Commission Formation and other reform proposals to ensure public oriented police services" at Syndicate Hall of the North South University organized by its South Asian Institute of Policy and Governance in Dhaka yesterday.

Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam said, the fascist Awami League (AL) will not be allowed to hold rallies in the country. Chief Adviser's Press Secretary said this in a post on his verified Facebook account yesterday.

Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP) Acting Chairman Tarique Rahman said, protection of farmers' interests will get highest priority if BNP is voted to power.
