Newsbrief

Bangladesh government strongly condemned the deplorable acts of desecrating the national flag of Bangladesh and the burning of the effigy of Chief Adviser Prof. Muhammad Yunus in Kolkata, India, according to a Foreign Ministry's statement yesterday. The Government of Bangladesh notes with deep concern the violent protest organized outside the Deputy High Commission of Bangladesh in Kolkata last Thursday by a Hindu organization of Kolkata named Bongio Hindu Jagran, said the statement. Bangladesh government condemned any form of violent activity and urged the India Government to ensure safety and security of the Deputy High Commission of Bangladesh in Kolkata and other Diplomatic Missions of Bangladesh in India as well as its diplomats and non-diplomatic staffs, the Foreign Ministry added.

Finance Adviser Dr. Salehuddin Ahmed underscored the need for a triangular approach to public financial management (PFM), integrating the efforts of the public sector, private sector and citizens to ensure efficient, transparent and accountable financial services. The Adviser said this while speaking as the chief guest at the 'Review Workshop on the 3rd PFM Reform Strategy 2025-2030' at a training center at Gazipur area yesterday.

Land Adviser A F Hassan Ariff said, the government will handle the miscreants with strict hands, if anyone try to create unrest. the interim government is pledge bound to handle everything with responsibility. So, any law-and-order situation will be controlled with strict hand. The Adviser said this in a views exchange meeting with the families of martyrs and leaders of the July student upsurge at circuit house in Chattogram yesterday.

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Adviser Dr. Asif Nazrul said, the interim government is working to stop exploitation of workers abroad. The Adviser said this in a post on his verified Facebook account yesterday.

A Taka one-crore fund is being raised for slain Lawyer Saiful Islam Alif under the supervision of Religious Affairs Adviser Dr. A. F. M. Khalid Hossain while humanitarian organization Alhaj Shamsul Hoque Foundation is collecting the fund. The Religious Affairs Adviser said this at a press briefing after offering ziarat at the grave of Lawyer Saiful Islam Alif in Pantrisha village of Lohagara in Chattogram yesterday. Primary and Mass Education Adviser Professor Dr. Bidhan Ranjan Roy Podder was also present.

Bangladesh reaffirmed in the United Nations (UN) that every Bangladeshi, regardless of religious identity, has the right to practice respective religion or express views freely. Bangladesh Permanent Representative Ambassador to the UN Tareq Md. Ariful Islam said this while delivering the statement at the 17th Session of UN Forum on Minority in Geneva on Thursday in Geneva.

Palestine Ambassador to Bangladesh Yousef SY Ramadan called upon all the countries of the world to take effective measures to bring an end the ongoing crimes of genocide, displacements and injustices with Palestinians by Israel. The Ambassador said this while addressing a symposium on Palestine Solidarity Day, organised by United Nations Association of Bangladesh (UNAB) marking the UN declared day of solidarity with Palestine, at hotel lake castle in the capital yesterday.

United Arab Emirates (UAE) government pardoned 75 more expatriate Bangladeshis who were detained for participating in demonstrations in the UAE in solidarity with July-August's anti-discrimination movement in Bangladesh. The release brings the total number of pardoned individuals to 188, said the Ministry of Expatriates' Welfare and Overseas Employment in a statement issued yesterday. Earlier, the UAE government released 113 expatriates on similar charges.

Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP) Secretary General Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir urged all to remain vigilant to sustain the achievements of the student-led mass uprising. The BNP Secretary General said this while addressing a convention of Thakurgaon Chhatra Kalyan Parishad at Krishibid Institution, Bangladesh (KIB) auditorium at Farmgate in Dhaka yesterday.
