Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus directed the authorities concerned to hold the Bangladesh Civil Service examination at a fixed time every year following annual calendar and ensuring transparency in the process. The Chief Adviser gave the directives at a meeting with Public Service Commission (PSC) officials at the State Guest House Jamuna in the capital yesterday. During the meeting, PSC Chairman Professor Dr Mobasser Monem spoke about the need for financial and administrative autonomy for the commission.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus directed the law enforcement agencies to extend all-out cooperation to Dhaka University authorities to ensure a peaceful and festive atmosphere during the Dhaka University Central Students' Union elections to be held tomorrow. The Chief Adviser gave the directive while presiding over a high-level meeting at the State Guest House Jamuna in the capital yesterday to review the law and order situation across the country.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus expressed profound shock and sorrow at the death of Badruddin Umar, one of the foremost leaders of the freedom loving people's struggle, a politician, progressive thinker, sociologist and writer. The Chief Adviser said this in a condolence message yesterday.

Finance Adviser Dr Salehuddin Ahmed sought cooperation and blessings from all concerned so that the interim government could turn this country into a better one for the future generation. The Adviser said this while addressing the Book Launch Ceremony of 'Bangladesher Rajnoitic Orthonity' authored by Dr Muhammad Fouzul Kabir Khan, Adviser, Ministry of Power, Energy and Mineral Resources; Ministry of Road Transport and Bridges; and Ministry of Railways. Director General of Bangladesh Institute of Development Studies (BIDS) Dr A K Enamul Haque moderated the event at the BIDS Conference Room. Adviser to the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change Syeda Rizwana Hasan and Adviser to the Ministry of Cultural Affairs Mostafa Sarwar Farooqi spoke at the event.

Planning Adviser Professor Wahid Uddin Mahmud said that legendary singer Sabina Yasmin is not only a national treasure but also an invaluable asset to the country. The Adviser said this at an honoring ceremony yesterday. The ceremony and performance event was organized by the Ministry of Cultural Affairs at the Bangladesh Shilpakala Academy. At the same Programme, Cultural Affairs Adviser Mostofa Sarwar Farooki said that a nation without history and culture is vulnerable.

Finance Adviser Dr Salehuddin Ahmed, Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Adviser Dr Asif Nazrul and Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md Mahfuj Alam expressed profound shock and sorrow at the death of prominent writer, researcher and Jatiya Mukti Council President Badruddin Umar. They expressed their shock and sorrow in separate messages of condolence yesterday. The Advisers said, Badruddin Umar was a man of versatile talents. His death is an irreparable loss for the country. The Advisers also prayed for eternal peace of the departed soul and conveyed sympathy to the bereaved family.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd.) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury instructed members of the police force to remain neutral and committed to serving the people, rather than aligning with any political party. The Adviser said this while addressing a training program aimed at enhancing the skills and capacity of police personnel for professional conduct during election duties. The event was held at the Rajarbagh Police Auditorium in the capital yesterday.

Land Adviser Ali Imam Majumdar urged newly appointed Assistant Commissioners (Land) to develop a people-friendly mindset and uphold ethical conduct in discharging their duties to strengthen the land administration system across the country. The Adviser made the remarks while addressing the inauguration ceremony of the 45th and 46th Basic Land Management Course for newly appointed ACs (Land) at the Land Administration Training Center (LATC) in the capital yesterday. The Adviser also warned that deviation from the legal path and neglect of public service values would tarnish the reputation of the administration cadre.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan said, objective and accountable media is indispensable in the national interest. The Adviser made this remark while speaking as the chief guest at a meeting on reviewing the report of the Media Reform Commission in a hotel of Dhaka yesterday. The Adviser said that the government has already formed a committee to implement the recommendations submitted by the Media Reform Commission.

Environment and Water Resources Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan underscored Brazil's crucial role as host of the upcoming UNFCCC COP30 in shaping the global climate agenda, reaffirming Bangladesh's commitment to work closely with Brazil for an ambitious and inclusive outcome. The Adviser made the remarks while addressing a reception hosted by Brazilian Ambassador to Bangladesh Paulo Fernando Dias Feres at a hotel of Dhaka yesterday to celebrate the 203rd anniversary of Brazil's independence.

Chittagong Hill Tracts (CHT) Affairs Adviser Supradip Chakma informed that under the directive of Chief Adviser Dr Muhammad Yunus, digital transformation of 100 schools in the hill tracts is underway using Star-link technology. The Adviser said this while meeting with three scandinavian diplomats at his office in the Chittagong Hill Tracts Heritage Preservation and Research Center, located on Bailey Road in the capital yesterday. The diplomats are Ambassador of Norway to Bangladesh Hakon Harald Gulbrandsen, Ambassador of the Royal Danish Embassy Christian Brix Moller and Second Secretary and Head of Politics at the Danish Embassy Olle Landin.

Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md. Mahfuj Alam said that journalists must play a vigilant and responsible role before, during and after the election. If this can be done, the distrust that has developed among the people toward the media will be removed, the Adviser said. The Adviser made the remarks while presiding over a views exchange meeting on the role of the media during elections at the conference room of the Department of Films and Publications at the Information Building in Dhaka yesterday.

The Ministry of Cultural Affairs accorded the honor to singer Sabina Yasmin at a ceremony held at the Bangladesh Shilpakala Academy yesterday. 
