Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md. Mahfuj Alam said that the individuals involved in enforced disappearances will be brought to justice during the tenure of the interim government. The Adviser made the remarks while exchanging views with the families of the victims of enforced disappearances. Human rights organizing 'Mayer Dak' organized the event in the capital's Tejgaon area yesterday. Criticizing ousted Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, the Adviser said, she used enforced disappearances and killings as a means of avenging her parents' assassination.

The New York Times article titled "As Bangladesh Reinvents Itself, Islamist Hard-Liners See an Opening" is a misleading one, said the Chief Adviser's Press Wing yesterday. The press wing said this in a statement posted on its verified Facebook page - CA Press Wing Facts.

Bangladesh sent the second mission of emergency medicines and relief supplies for the victims of the devastating earthquake in Myanmar. The mission consists of rescue and medical teams composed of rescue experts from all three services and doctors, Chief Adviser's Deputy Press Secretary Abul Kalam Azad Majumder said yesterday.
