Finance Adviser Salehuddin Ahmed said, the country's 15 years of corruption and irregularities cannot be eliminated in only three or four months. However, stability started to return to the economy which was beginning to deteriorate, the Adviser said this while addressing a programme at a hotel organised by the Dhaka Chamber of Commerce and Industry in Dhaka yesterday.

Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain said, India needs to address Bangladesh's longstanding concerns to improve bilateral ties between Dhaka and New Delhi. The Adviser said this while speaking at a roundtable titled 'Bangladesh-India Relations: Expectations, Barriers and Future'. The South Asian Institute of Policy and Governance and the Department of Political Science and Sociology of North South University hosted the event at its campus in the capital yesterday.

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Adviser Dr. Asif Nazrul called upon all the stakeholders of the mass uprising to maintain unity to sustain its achievements and materialize the aspirations of the martyrs. The Adviser said this while addressing a memorial meeting on July uprising titled 'Smritir Minar: Gono Abhyuthan-2024', organized by Bangladesh Sangbad Sangstha at Tofazzal Hossain Manik Mia Hall at Jatiya press Club in Dhaka yesterday.


