Newsbrief

The Council of Advisers approved in principle the draft of 'The Code of Criminal Procedure (Amendment) Ordinance, 2025'. The approval came at a meeting of the council held at the Chief Adviser's Office (CAO) with Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus in the chair, a Cabinet Division press release said yesterday. The council also approved a proposal of declaring all services of the National Board of Revenue as 'Essential Services'. Besides, the Council of Advisers decided to observe 'July Shaheed Dibosh' on July 16. It also decided to observe 'July Mass Uprising Day' on August 5 and not to celebrate any special day on August 8.

National Consensus Commission Vice-Chairman Professor Ali Riaz hoped for signing the July Charter based on the consensus of all parties on the martyrdom day of Shaheed Abu Sayed. Professor Riaz made the hope while delivering his opening remark at the beginning of a discussion of the commission with the political parties starting at the Foreign Service Academy in Dhaka yesterday.

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Adviser Dr Asif Nazrul said, new rules have been incorporated in the Code of Criminal Procedure to stop filing of fake cases and harassment of innocents in these regards. The Adviser said these while addressing a press briefing at Foreign Service Academy in the capital yesterday after the Advisory Council meeting.

In a bid to resolve the ongoing deadlock at the National Board of Revenue, the government has constituted a five-member Adviser-level panel to mediate the crisis triggered by the work abstention of revenue officials. The committee, headed by Energy Adviser Fouzul Kabir Khan, was tasked with addressing the concerns of the agitating officials and bringing an end to the ongoing crisis swiftly, according to a statement issued by the Cabinet Division yesterday. The other members of the panel include Housing and Public Works Adviser Adilur Rahman Khan, Labour and Employment Adviser Brigadier General (Retd) M Sakhawat Hussain, Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan and Commerce Adviser Sk Bashir Uddin. The committee was formed to resolve the crisis fast, the Cabinet Division said in its statement.

The Ministry of Information and Broadcasting has taken a preliminary decision to establish the BCS Information Academy. This Academy will be built at a suitable location in the capital. The decision was made at a meeting recently held at the Ministry with Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md. Mahfuj Alam in the chair. Regarding the establishment of the BCS Information Academy the Adviser said, the activities to establish this academy will start during the current interim government.

Religious Affairs Adviser Dr AFM Khalid Hossain stressed on reorganizing the 'Imams' for taking forward the changing trend of society towards moral and ideological values. The Adviser said this while addressing the National Hifzul Quran and Sirat competition and National conference of the Imam-'25 as the chief guest at Osmani Memorial Auditorium in Dhaka yesterday.

Fisheries and Livestock Adviser Farida Akhter emphasized the crucial role of animal health in ensuring human nutrition and national food security. The Adviser said this while speaking at the Dean's Award and Orientation-2024 program, organized by the Faculty of Animal Science and Veterinary Medicine at Sher-e-Bangla Agricultural University yesterday. The Adviser also said, Ministry of Fisheries and Livestock is playing a vital role in meeting the country's animal protein needs.

The High Court (HC) yesterday ordered authorities concerned to provide appropriate security to the rape victim of Muradnagar upazila of Cumilla district. It also ordered to remove all the photographs and video footages of the victims from the social networking sites within 24 hours and filing report on progress in the case in the next 15 days. The HC division bench of Justice Fahmida Quader and Justice Sayed Jahed Mansur passed the order after holding a hearing on a writ petition filed in this connection.

The Election Commission (EC) is going to start voter registration and NID distribution activities for the Bangladeshi expatriates living in Japan. The EC issued a notification in this regard yesterday. A technical team will conduct the activates from the Bangladesh Embassy in Japan form July 7. EC Senior Secretary Akhter Ahmed will monitor the campaign.

Chief Adviser's Press Wing has binned the narratives which are circulating on social media over the decline in the Bangladesh's position in Global Peace Index under the interim government saying the claim is entirely misleading. The Press Wing said this in a statement posted on its verified Facebook page - CA Press Wing Facts the day before yesterday.

A total of 13 new Covid-19 cases were reported in Bangladesh in the last 24 hours till Sunday morning, according to the Directorate General of Health Services yesterday.




