Lauding the role of non-resident Bangladeshis, Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus said, the remittance of Bangladeshi expatriates saved the country's economy after the July uprising. The Chief Adviser told an event in New York yesterday. The event titled 'NRB Connect Day: Empowering Global Bangladeshis' was held at New York Marriott Marquis, Manhattan, where non-resident Bangladeshis were present. Speaking on the occasion, the Chief Adviser said, he is personally very hopeful of Bangladesh. Bangladesh has enough young manpower. The Chief Adviser asked foreign firms to relocate their factories in Bangladesh to utilize these young human resources and consider Bangladesh a production hub.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus greeted all Hindu citizens of the country on the occasion of Durga Puja, the biggest religious festival of the Bangalee Hindu community, beginning today. The Chief Adviser said this in a message yesterday on the festival. The Chief Adviser said, destruction of evil forces and adoration of truth and beauty are the main features of the Sharadiyo Durgotsab. Noting that Bangladesh is a country of communal harmony, the Chief Adviser added.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus and his daughter Deena Yunus attended a reception hosted by US President Donald Trump in New York on September 23. The Chief Adviser extended an invitation to Trump to visit Bangladesh at his convenient time at that time. During the reception, US President Donald Trump and First Lady Melania Trump posed for a picture with Prof. Yunus and his daughter. The photo was posted on the Chief Adviser's verified Facebook account the day before yesterday.

Dozens of global leaders gathered to meet Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus at his hotel suite in New York of USA the day before yesterday, offering their full support to him and his interim government. They expressed readiness to provide their expertise and assistance to Bangladesh during this pivotal time. A delegation, led by former President of Latvia Vaira Vike-Freiberga, met Professor Yunus on the sidelines of the United Nations General Assembly. Vike-Freiberga is also co-chair of the Nizami Ganjavi International Center, named after the renowned 11th-century Persian poet. The world leaders praised Professor Yunus's leadership and lifelong dedication to eradicating poverty and promoting social justice.



The Adviser made the call while attending the Annual Coordination Meeting of the Foreign Ministers of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation held on the sidelines of the 80th UN General Assembly High-Level Week at the UN Headquarters the day before yesterday, according to a message yesterday.

Liberation War Affairs Adviser Faruk-e-Azam called upon all concern to remain alert of rumors during the Durga Puja celebration. The Adviser requested all not to react instantly after hearing any incidents based on rumor and to verify the information before taking any action. The Adviser also stressed the need to avoid any sorts of inconvenience in and around the Puja mandaps based on misunderstandings. The Adviser made these remarks while speaking as the chief guest at a clothes distribution program on the occasion of Sharadiya Durga Puja celebration organized by the Chattogram chapter of Bangladesh Puja Ujapan Parishad in Chattogram yesterday.

Religious Affairs Adviser A F M Khalid Hossain said, higher education is key to build a prosperous nation. He also said, higher education creates scopes for better employment and ensures economic stability and also allows individuals to be more confident and advance towards prosperity. The Adviser said this while speaking as the chief guest at a reunion program at the International Islamic University Chittagong in Chattagram yesterday.

Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) AMM Nasir Uddin said, the election officials will not be given any unlawful instructions in the 13th National Parliament election, even they will not be ordered to favor anyone. The CEC said these while addressing the 'Election Officers Conference 2025' at the Nirbachan Bhaban in Agargaon area in Dhaka yesterday.




