### Newsbrief

Housing and Public Works Adviser Adilur Rahman Khan said that the people of Bangladesh, particularly the youth will resist and defeat fascism by foiling any conspiracy in the future. The Adviser made the remarks while inaugurating the newly built July Martyrs Memorial Monument in front of the Government Public Library in Natore yesterday.

Education Adviser Professor Dr CR Abrar urged the students to develop themselves as the self-respecting citizens by rising above all sorts of greediness. The Adviser made the call at the closing and award giving ceremony of the 4th National Eco Carnival 2025 organized by St. Gregory High School and College in the capital yesterday.

Environment, Forest, Climate Change and Water Resources Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan urged the people to remain aware and united to protect water bodies. The Adviser told a dialogue and best award ceremony at the CIRDAP auditorium in the capital yesterday. Urban Development Journalist Forum organized the programme titled 'Dhaka Water Body Restoration and Potential'. Noting that there is no alternative to restoring water bodies, the Adviser also said, Dhaka will survive if water bodies are saved.




