### Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus visited Dhaka University campus in Dhaka yesterday to see the graffiti drawn by young revolutionaries during the student-led mass uprising in July and August. During the visit, Law Adviser Professor Dr. Asif Nazul, Information and Broadcasting Adviser Nahid Islam, Youth and Sports Adviser Asif Mahmud Sojib Bhuiyan and Chief Adviser's Special Assistant Mahfuj Alam accompanied the Chief Adviser. The messages reflect the spirit of the revolution and the aspirations of the people to build a discrimination-free Bangladesh.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus stressed the need for enhanced trade and economic cooperation between Bangladesh and Bhutan. The Chief Adviser said this when Bhutanese Ambassador in Dhaka Rinchen Kuentsyl paid a courtesy call on him at the State Guest House Jamuna yesterday.

Foreign Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain expressed deep concern over the recent influx of more than 40,000 Rohingyas into Bangladesh fleeing conflict in Myanmar's bordering states. The Adviser raised the concern when Myanmar Ambassador to Bangladesh U Kyaw Soe Moe paid a maiden call on him at his Ministry in Dhaka yesterday. During the talks, the Foreign Adviser emphasized the urgency of a safe and sustainable repatriation process for the displaced Rohingya population, highlighting the importance of peace and stability in Myanmar.

Posts, Telecommunications and Information Technology Adviser Nahid Islam said, Bangladesh's interim government does not recognise Sheikh Mujibur Rahman as the father of the nation. The Adviser made the remarks in response to a question from journalists at the Secretariat yesterday. The Adviser said in response to another question from journalists that the national days being canceled were imposed by the Awami League, describing this as "fascist behaviour."

The Council of Advisers of the Interim Government has recently decided to cancel eight national days, according to a post on verified Facebook page of the Chief Adviser (CA). CA's press wing also confirmed this yesterday.

Various organizations and individuals donated Taka 2,50,47,000 to the relief fund of the Chief Adviser to support the people affected by recent flood. Faruk E Azam Bir Protik, Adviser of the interim government on the Ministry of Disaster Management and Relief received the cheques of the donation on behalf of the Chief Adviser at his Secretariat office in Dhaka yesterday.

British High Commissioner to Bangladesh Sarah Cooke met with Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain and discussed the UK's support for Bangladesh's interim government. Both of them also discussed the ongoing Rohingya crisis while the Adviser highlighted Bangladesh's immense burden in hosting over one million displaced people from Myanmar. The two sides also discussed the need for stronger international cooperation to ensure the safe and sustainable repatriation of the displaced Rohingya population.

As per the special directives of Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan, 155.09 acres of land of Bangladesh Forest Industries Development Corporation (BFIDC) have been recovered from illegal occupation, according to a Ministry's press release yesterday.

The government started selling essential goods at fair prices for ready-made garment workers through the Trading Corporation of Bangladesh. Labour and Employment Adviser Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuyain inaugurated the programme at a function held at the Jaber & Zubair Fabrics Limited factory in Gazipur yesterday.

Jute and Textile Adviser Brig. Gen. (retd) Dr. M Sakhawat Hussain urged South Korea to come up with investments in jute and textile sectors. The Adviser said this when South Korean Ambassador to Bangladesh Envoy Park Young-sik called on him at his Ministry in Dhaka yesterday.

Three more deaths was reported from dengue and 1186 more patients were hospitalized with viral fever till Tuesday morning, according to the Directorate General of Health Services yesterday.

The prime index of the DSE decreased by 49.75 points, settling at 5,316.21 points yesterday.
