Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus called for moving forward in creating the future world applying the Scouting experience. The Chief Adviser made the call while addressing the inaugural session of the nationwide Cub Carnival and the Shapla Cub Award distribution ceremony organized by Bangladesh Scouts at the Chief Adviser's Office in Dhaka yesterday. The Chief Adviser also said, the history was created with the eight scouts, who sacrificed their lives for the sake of the country and its people and to create a new Bangladesh.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd.) Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said, the way the 'mob justice' was carried out during the arrest of former Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) KM Nurul Huda 'is not acceptable'. The Adviser told reporters after visiting the Horticulture Centre in Mouchak, Kaliakair upazila of Gazipur district yesterday. The Home Adviser also urged everyone not to take the law into their own hands, insisting that people should hand over offenders to law enforcement agencies for appropriate legal action.

Education Adviser Prof. Dr. C R Abrar said, the education system of Bangladesh has been destroyed during the last 17 years. The Adviser said this while addressing a 'Research Fair' arranged by the Noakhali University of Science and Technology in Noakhali yesterday.

Youth and Sports Adviser Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuyain said, the previous autocratic government took away the voting rights of the youth, suppressed their voices and snatched away their future. The Adviser made the remark while speaking at an event titled 'Commonwealth Charter Youth Workshop' at hotel in the capital yesterday.

Chief Adviser's Special Assistant on Posts, Telecommunications and Information Technology Faiz Ahmed Taiyeb said, those who cannot avail services on smartphones and computers can receive citizen services through entrepreneurs from Ek Thikana Nagorik Sheba platform. He made the remarks while speaking as the chief guest at a workshop organized at the Bangladesh computer council auditorium at the ICT Tower in Agargaon the day before yesterday.

The European Union (EU) has committed to invest one billion Euro in Bangladesh across key sectors including water, energy, transport and health, with plans underway to further double this financing, according to the EU Delegation to Bangladesh. The announcement came following a series of high-level stakeholder meetings held last week in Dhaka, organized jointly by the EU Delegation and the European Investment Bank (EIB). The EU said this in its official facebook page yesterday.
