National Cooperatives Day is being observed in the country today with the theme 'Somobaye Gorbo Desh, Boishommohin Bangladesh'. President Mohammed Shahabuddin and Chief Adviser to the interim government Dr. Muhammad Yunus yesterday issued separate messages greeting the members of the cooperatives on the day. The President, in his message said, the key element of poverty alleviation is economic development, and the best way of economic development is 'cooperative'. The Chief Adviser Dr. Muhammad Yunus, in his message said that the current interim government has taken up the challenge of building a new discrimination-free new Bangladesh through reforms. The cooperative sector has been playing a crucial role in poverty alleviation and socio-economic development of the country, the Chief Adviser added.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus hosted a reception for SAFF Championship winning Bangladesh women's football team at the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka today, the Chief Adviser's press wing said yesterday.

LGRD and Cooperatives Adviser AF Hassan Ariff said, the present interim government is working to make a discrimination-free society as the martyred students and people have struggled to this end. The Adviser said this while participating in a discussion organized by Mahanagar Sarbajanin Puja Committee and Bangladesh Puja Udjapan Parishad in the capital's Dhakeshwari National Temple yesterday.

Posts, Telecommunications and Information Technology Adviser Md. Nahid Islam said, the young generation will lead Bangladesh in all aspects. The Adviser made the remarks while addressing a function organized to mark the National Youth Day-2024 at the Osmani Memorial Auditorium in Dhaka yesterday. At the same programme, Youth and Sports Adviser Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuyain said, five lakh jobs will be created in the next two years.
