### Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus directed the authorities concerned to conduct an investigation into the killing of a Lawyer in Chattogram port city and take appropriate legal measures to this end. Condemning the murder of the Lawyer, the Chief Adviser urged people to keep calm and stay away from participating in any untoward activities. In a statement issued by the Chief Adviser's press wing yesterday.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus urged top executives of multinational companies operating in Bangladesh to team up with the government to advocate and promote Bangladesh to potential investors and ensure business opportunities expanded in the country. The Chief Adviser made the call when over a dozen Chief Executive officers, Managing Directors and country Heads called on him at the State Guest House Jamuna yesterday to discuss business and investment opportunities in Bangladesh.

The Chief Adviser reiterated Bangladesh's unwavering commitment to justice, freedom, peace and supporting the Palestinian quest for the full realization of all of their inalienable rights and aspirations to live a safe, stable and dignified life. On the occasion of the International Day of Solidarity with the Palestinian People, the Chief Adviser in a message yesterday said, Bangladesh stands resolutely with the people of Palestine in their rightful struggle for self-determination and statehood.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus hailed Bangladesh Shipping Corporation (BSC) for setting examples for others by continuing to make profit. The Chief Adviser yesterday made the comments when BSC handed him over a cheque of Taka 475.25 crore as installment of a loan the organization obtained from the government and China Exim Bank in 2016.

The United States welcomed Chief Advisor Professor Muhammad Yunus's assurances that labor reforms are a top priority of the Interim Government, according to a media note issued by the US Embassy in Dhaka yesterday.


