Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus has called upon the young generation to nurture their understanding of policymaking as a continuous and adaptive process, emphasizing that the success or failure of any venture largely depends on the quality of its policy framework. The Chief Adviser made the remarks while exchanging greetings with the winning students of the National Policy Competition 2025, organized by the Ministry of Youth and Sports, at the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka yesterday.

The government gave the final approval to the draft of 'July Uprising Memorial Museum Ordinance 2025', establishing the July Uprising Museum as a fully independent national institution to preserve and honour the memory of the student-people uprising. The Council of Advisers gave the final approval to the draft of the ordinance at its weekly meeting held at the Chief Adviser's Office in Dhaka yesterday with Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus in the chair. At the same meeting, the government also gave final approval to the draft of the National Human Rights Commission Ordinance-2025 with significant reforms aimed at transforming the commission into a truly empowered and effective institution.

Law Adviser Professor Dr Asif Nazrul said that Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus will take the final decision regarding the implementation of the National Consensus Commission's recommendations and referendum. The Adviser said this while replying to a question at a press briefing at the Foreign Service Academy in Dhaka yesterday after the Advisory Council meeting.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change and Water Resources Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan said, ensuring women's health and empowerment is essential for achieving sustainable development. The Adviser made the remarks while speaking as the Chief Guest at an event titled 'Joining hands for improving women's healthcare in Bangladesh,' held at the Westin Hotel in Dhaka yesterday.

Fisheries and Livestock Adviser Farida Akhter said, rural women are playing a crucial role in strengthening the country's nutrition base and rural economy through their tireless efforts. The Adviser made the remarks while addressing a national seminar titled 'Rural Women in Climate Adaptation' as the chief guest at the Bangladesh Parjatan Corporation auditorium in the capital yesterday.

As the nation is set for an election festivity with 13th National Parliament elections draw near, the Election Commission in full swing is working to complete all necessary preparations for participatory, free, fair and neutral polls. Election Commissioner Anwarul Islam Sarkar said this to reporters at his office in the capital yesterday.

The Election Commission (EC) has updated the list of election symbols for registered political parties and independent candidates for the upcoming 13th Jatiya Sangsad election. Four new symbols — including 'Shapla Koli' have been added to the previous list of 115, bringing the total number of symbols to 119. A gazette notification, signed by Senior Secretary of the EC Secretariat Akhtar Ahmed, was published in this regard yesterday.
