Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus said, every country needs accurate hydrographic data for development. The Chief Adviser said this in a message on the occasion of the World Hydrography Day 2025 today. The Chief Adviser said, the interim government is working with the goal of transforming Bangladesh into a productive and regional economic hub. Prof. Yunus also said, the Hydrographic Department of the Bangladesh Navy is working tirelessly to conduct hydrographic survey, prepare charts and make sure the safety of all local and foreign ships and exchange information and data according to international standards.

Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain warned that the unresolved Rohingya crisis could soon escalate into a serious threat to regional security if a sustainable solution is not urgently pursued. The Adviser made the remark while addressing a high-level open debate at the United Nations Security Council titled 'The impact of poverty, underdevelopment and conflict on international peace and security' at the UN headquarters in New York the day before yesterday.

Food Adviser Ali Imam Majumder said, the country's food situation remains highly satisfactory, thanks to a bumper Boro harvest, significantly boosting food grain stocks. The Adviser said this while speaking at a view-exchange meeting with food department officials from Patuakhali and Barguna at the Patuakhali Circuit House yesterday.

Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives Adviser Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuyain said, everyone's responsible behaviour is necessary to ensure good coexistence of political parties with the government. The Adviser wrote this in a post on his verified Facebook account yesterday. The Adviser also said, he did not take the decision alone regarding the project going to be taken in Dhaka South City Corporation.

Bangladesh has requested the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia to retain the current minimum quota of 1,000 pilgrims per Hajj agency, instead of implementing the planned increase to 2,000 in 2026. The request was made by Religious Affairs Adviser Dr AFM Khalid Hossain during a meeting with Saudi Deputy Minister for Hajj and Umrah Al-Hassan Yahya Al-Manakhara. The meeting took place at the Ministry of Hajj and Umrah in Jeddah yesterday. During the meeting, Khalid expressed his appreciation for the Saudi government's successful management of the Hajj pilgrimage in 2025.

Outgoing German Ambassador in Dhaka Achim Troster paid a courtesy call on former Prime Minister and BNP Chairperson Begum Khaleda Zia at her Gulshan residence Feroza yesterday. BNP Standing Committee members Dr. Abdul Moyeen Khan, Dr. AZM Zahid Hossain and BNP Chairperson's Private Secretary ABM Abdus Sattar were present on the occasion.

Bangladesh signed loan agreements worth \$1.3 billion with the Asian Development Bank (ADB) to finance four major development projects focusing on climate resilience, renewable energy, transport infrastructure and reforms in the banking sector. The agreements were signed between the Economic Relations Division (ERD) and ADB at a ceremony held at ERD in the capital yesterday. Md. Shahriar Kader Siddiky, Secretary of ERD and Hoe Yun Jeong, Country Director of ADB, signed the documents on behalf of the government of Bangladesh and ADB respectively.

Bangladesh archer Abdur Rahman Alif won gold medal in the men's recurve individual event of Asia Cup Stage-2, beating his Japanese archer Miyata Gakuto 6-4 in the gold-deciding match held in Singapore yesterday.
