Newsbrief

The government gave final approval to the draft of the Referendum Ordinance 2025 in line with the July National Charter Implementation Order 2025. The Council of Advisers gave the approval at a special meeting held at the Chief Adviser's Office yesterday with Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus in the chair. Law Adviser Professor Dr Asif Nazrul briefed the media on the matter at the Foreign Service Academy in the capital.

The newly appointed Ambassador of France to Bangladesh, Jean-Marc Séré-Charlet, has expressed France's readiness to initiate a new phase in its bilateral relations with Bangladesh, underscoring the strong alignment of interests between the two nations, particularly in the areas of democracy, development and regional cooperation. The Ambassador made the remarks during a courtesy call on Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus at the State Guest House Jamuna, said Chief Adviser's Press Wing yesterday.

The probe body formed to investigate the devastating the fire at Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport (HSIA) cargo village submitted its report to the Chief Adviser Professor Mumahhad Yunus, stating that the fire was originated from an electrical short circuit. Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam said this at a briefing at the Foreign Service Academy yesterday.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus yesterday issued a message on the occasion of the International Day of Solidarity with the Palestinian People. In his message, the Chief Adviser said, on the occasion with the Palestinian People Bangladesh also joins the international community in reaffirming her persistent and unwavering commitment to the realization of the inalienable rights of the Palestinian People to self-determination to achieve an independent, sovereign and viable State of Palestine on the basis of the pre-1967 borders, with East Jerusalem as its capital.

The government launched an initiative to send workers, who could not go to Malaysia by May 31 last year, while as part of this programme, a flight carrying 60 workers departed Dhaka for Malaysia. Expatriates' Welfare and Overseas Employment Adviser Dr Asif Nazrul was present at Probashi Lounge at Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport in Dhaka and saw them off.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan said, the government is ready to work sincerely on any policy support or environmental intervention that can bring real benefits to the lives of the Munda community. The Adviser said this while virtually speaking at an event titled 'National Sharing Meeting: From Impact to Action - Mainstreaming Climate Resilience for the Munda Community' held at a hotel of Dhaka yesterday

Shipping Adviser Brigadier General (ret'd) Dr M Sakhawat Hossain said that Bangladesh has advanced from a coastal economy to an emerging maritime nation, driven by modernization, innovation and sustainable development. The Adviser made the remarks while addressing the inaugural session of the 34th General Assembly of the International Maritime Organization in London the day before yesterday, according to a Ministry press release yesterday.

Primary and Mass Education Adviser Professor Dr Bidhan Ranjan Roy Podder emphasized the need for increased research on the challenges hindering the development of primary education. The Adviser told a workshop on presentation of research reports organized by the National Academy for Primary Education at the auditorium of the Primary Teacher Training Institute in Dhaka yesterday. Power, Energy and Mineral Resources Adviser Muhammad Fozul Kabir Khan also spoke the workshop.

Social Welfare and Women and Children Affairs Adviser Sharmeen Soneya Murshid said, women remain unsafe in cyberspace and are facing harassment at every step. The Adviser made the remarks while formally inaugurating the '16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence 2025' national dialogue at the Bangladesh-China Friendship Convention Centre in Dhaka yesterday. The event was jointly organized by the Local Consultative Group on Women's Advancement and Gender Equality and the United Nations.

Social Welfare and Women and Children Affairs Adviser Sharmeen S Murshid has urged all quarters to work together to build a safe, non-discriminatory and developed Bangladesh for women and children in line with the spirit of the July Uprising. The Adviser said this while addressing a view-sharing meeting titled 'Government in the Line of the People for the Protection of Marginalized Disabled, Women and Children' at the Rangpur Medical College auditorium yesterday.

Religious Affairs Adviser Dr AFM Khalid Hossain said, the decades-long efforts of Islamic scholars and clerics have not gone in vain, as Islamic forces have once again gathered the strength to stand with dignity despite 54 years of repression and adversity. The Adviser told a seminar titled 'Muslim Family Law: The Bangladesh Context', organized by the Bangladesh Mosque Mission, at the main auditorium of the National Museum yesterday.

Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) AMM Nasir Uddin urged all election observers to maintain transparency and impartiality in performing their duties for the 13th Jatiya Sangsad elections. The CEC told a dialogue with representatives from 40 observation organizations at the Election Commission Bhaban at Agargaon yesterday.

Election Commissioner Brig. Gen. (Retd.) Abul Fazal Md. Sanaullah said, the schedule for the upcoming 13th Jatiya Sangsad election will be announced any day in the first half of December. The Election Commissioner made this remarks during his opening speech at the second phase of the Election Commission's dialogue with local election observer organizations at the conference room of Nirbachan Bhaban in the capital's Agargaon yesterday.

Foreign Secretary Asad Alam Siam has called on the international community to provide stronger financial and resource support to the United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) so it can better assist the industrialization needs of the global south. Bangladesh is participating in the 21st Session of the UNIDO General Conference, taking place in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia, from November 23-27, according to a press release issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs yesterday. The theme of this year's conference is 'Global Industrial Summit 2025.' The Foreign Secretary is leading the Bangladesh delegation.

Bangladesh and the United Nations emphasised strengthened cooperation with the Maldives to ensure the rights, security and welfare of immigrant workers, mostly Bangladeshis, in the Maldives. The discussion was held during a meeting between UN Resident Coordinator in Maldives Hao Zhang and Bangladesh High Commissioner to the Maldives Dr Md. Nazmul Islam in Mal, on Monday, according to a message received in Dhaka yesterday.

Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) Chairman Dr Mohammad Abdul Momen said that the commission would publish names of those who will try to create illegal pressure on it. The ACC Chairman said this while exchanging views with journalists at the ACC conference room in the capital on the occasion of its founding anniversary.
