Newsbrief

United Nations Resident Coordinator in Dhaka Gwyn Lewis praised Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus for his 'highly successful' visit to New York during the United Nations General Assembly as she paid a farewell call on him at the State Guest House Jamuna yesterday. Lewis highlighted the powerful demonstration of national unity reflected in the diverse composition of the Bangladesh delegation, as it for the first time included six leaders of major political parties.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus yesterday said, every girl child must be ensured safety, quality education and nutrition and must be transformed into skilled human resources as they will be the future mothers, future citizens. The Chief Adviser said this in a message on the National Girl Child Day-2025. The Chief Adviser also wished success of all the programs organized on the occasion of National Girl Child Day-2025.

Finance Adviser Dr Salehuddin Ahmed said that discussions are ongoing with various international development partners, including the IMF, ADB, IDB, and the World Bank for availing support in various sectors in line with the country's demands. The Adviser was responding to the queries of reporters after chairing a meeting on the Advisers Council Committee on Government Purchase at the Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

Foreign Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain laid emphasis on promoting trade and investment as well as a bridge for friendship between the two brotherly nations- Bangladesh and Saudi Arabia. The Adviser made the remark while speaking at the inauguration ceremony of the Saudi Arabia-Bangladesh Chamber of Commerce and Industry at a hotel of Dhaka yesterday.

Bangladesh and Türkiye discussed ways to deepen bilateral defence cooperation alongside expanding engagements in trade, education and labour mobility. The discussion took place when Turkish Deputy Foreign Minister A. Berris Ekinci paid a courtesy call on Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain at the Foreign Ministry yesterday.

Land Adviser Ali Imam Majumder said, the agricultural land is not only an area of production but it also a part of livelihood, culture and life of the economy and protecting the arable land has now become a national challenge. The Adviser came up with the remarks while addressing as a chair a draft review meeting on 'Land Zoning and Agricultural Land Protection Ordinance, 2025 at the Land Ministry conference room yesterday.

Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives Adviser Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuiyan said, the memorial erected in memory of BUET student Abrar Fahad stands as a lasting symbol of the nation's struggle against aggression and for sovereignty. The Adviser said this while addressing the memorial discussion and inauguration programme of 'Eight Pillars Against Aggression' memorial which was rebuilt and inaugurated at the Palashi intersection in the capital yesterday.

Health Adviser Nur Jahan Begum instructed the authorities concerned to take all-out steps to achieve 100 percent coverage of typhoid vaccination that will begin from October 12 across the country. The Adviser said this while addressing as the chief guest the National Advocacy Meeting on 'Typhoid Vaccination Campaign-2025', held at Shaheed Abu Sayeed Convention Hall in capital's Shahbagh area yesterday.

Social Welfare Adviser Sharmeen S Murshid announced her commitment to restructure government-run institutions by eliminating widespread corruption and making them self-sufficient. The Adviser said this while talking to journalists after visiting the Physically Handicapped Protection Trust at Tongi, Gazipur yesterday.

Newly-appointed Ambassador of Germany to Bangladesh Dr Rüdiger Lotz met Commerce Adviser Sk. Bashir Uddin at his office at Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday. During the meeting, both sides discussed in detail various aspects of bilateral trade, investment and economic cooperation between Bangladesh and Germany. The Adviser also urged German importers to import more products from Bangladesh, including ready-made garments, home textiles, pharmaceuticals, plastic goods, footwear, bicycles and leather products.

The Supreme Courts of Bangladesh and Egypt have signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) to enhance mutual cooperation in the judicial sector. Chief Justice Dr Syed Refaat Ahmed took part in a series of events in Cairo yesterday. As part of his visit, the Chief Justice called on Justice Boulos Fahmy at the Supreme Constitutional Court in Cairo and held a meeting on strengthening bilateral judicial cooperation, exchange of knowledge and experience and improving judicial efficiency and transparency.

Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) AMM Nasir Uddin said, acceptable and transparent election to the nation and sought cooperation of all to this end. The CEC made the remarks while addressing a view-exchange meeting with election experts at the conference room of the Election Commission Secretariat, Agargaon, in the capital yesterday.

Bangladesh has been elected President of the 43rd General Conference of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO), marking a historic milestone in the country's 53-year membership with the organisation. During the vote held at the 222nd Session of the UNESCO Executive Board in Paris yesterday, Bangladesh candidate Ambassador Khondker M Talha secured the presidency with a 30-27 victory over Japan.

International Crimes Tribunal (ICT) Chief Prosecutor Muhammad Tajul Islam said, a formal investigation has begun into the crimes committed by the Awami League as a party. The Chief Prosecutor said this while speaking to reporters at the premises of ICT in Dhaka yesterday. The Chief Prosecutor also said an investigation officer has already been appointed in this regard.

Bangladesh's economy bounced back strongly in the latter half of FY25 driven by robust export growth, record remittance inflows and an increase in foreign exchange reserves following disruptions in the first half of the year, according to a new World Bank report released yesterday.

More two dengue patients were died and 715 were hospitalized in across the country in the past 24 hours till Tuesday morning, according to a press release issued by the Directorate General of Health Services said yesterday.




