Newsbrief

Vice President of SpaceX, Lauren Dreyer, has commended the coordinated efforts of government officials in Bangladesh for supporting the effective launching of Starlink in the country. She made the remarks during a meeting with Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus at the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka yesterday.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury (Retd.) vowed to arrest all involved in the attack on the top leaders of the National Citizen Party (NCP) in Gopalganj recently. The Adviser said this while briefing newsmen on the Gopalganj incident at the Home Ministry yesterday.

With the aim of utilizing the potential of Kaptai Lake to improve the fate of the people of the Chattogram Hill Tracts (CHT), Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain and CHT Affairs Adviser Supradip Chakma exchanged views with officials concerned in the district. The two Advisers visited Kaptai Lake by riding a speedboat from Bargee Lake Valley in Rangamati via Shuvolong Waterfall, Shuvolong Bazar to Stadium Ghat in Rangamati town, according to a press release yesterday.

Youth and Sports Adviser Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuiyan participated in a symbolic marathon organised by his Ministry commemorating the July-August mass uprising day. The marathon started from the old trade fair ground in Sher-e-Bangla Nagar yesterday.

Religious Affairs Adviser Dr. AFM Khalid Hossain urged imams to address social issues in light of Islamic teachings during sermons (Khutba) of Jumma prayers. He also mentioned that a mosque management policy would soon be published in the official gazette, which would help ensure job security and a fixed monthly salary for imams, muezzins and caretakers. The Adviser made the comments as chief guest while inaugurating the Khulna City Model Mosque and Islamic Cultural Center along with a divisional imam conference titled 'Role of Imams and Islamic Scholars in Establishing Communal Harmony and Tackling Social Issues such as Terrorism, Corruption, Drugs, Dowry and Violence against Women,' held at the mosque in Nur Nagar in Khulna yesterday.

Bangladesh and the UN Human Rights Office recently signed a three-year Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to open a mission in the country to support the promotion and protection of human rights, according to the UN right office in Geneva yesterday. The MoU was signed by UN High Commissioner for Human Rights Volker Türk and Asad Alam Siam, Foreign Secretary, on behalf of the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh.

Lauren Dreyer, Vice President of Global Operations at Starlink, SpaceX said, Ministry of Posts, Telecommunications and Information Technology is proud to mark a historic moment in Bangladesh's digital journey with the official launch of Starlink services in the country. She said this while addressing at a press briefing held in Dhaka yesterday.

Local administration yesterday announced to keep Gopalganj under curfew until 6am today to maintain the law and order. District Magistrate of Gopalganj Muhammad Kamruzzaman imposed the curfew in the entire Gopalganj in order to maintain public order, peace and security of life and property of the people.

Bangladesh Railway (BR) in a statement yesterday said, there will be no disruption of normal train services due to approving the operation of four pairs of special trains today following the Jamaat-e-Islami's application on the occasion of its grand rally. In the statement BR also said, misleading information is being observed on various social media platforms regarding the issue.

Fact-checking platform BanglaFact, operated by the Press Institute Bangladesh (PIB) has identified a video claiming that it was the footage of a second attack on NCP leaders and activists in Gopalganj, which is actually an old video of a clash between Gopalganj university students and Sheikh Sayera Khatun Medical College students. PIB issued a statement in this regard yesterday.

One more person died and 114 others were hospitalized with dengue in the 24 hours till Friday morning, according to the Directorate General of Health Services yesterday.
