#### Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus urged Islamic NGOs to take up more social business to support the Muslim world. The Chief Adviser made the call when a group of NGO leaders from different Muslim countries met him at the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka yesterday. The Chief Adviser also said, social business is a good way to carry out this support, adding that he was encouraging young people around the world to take up social business and become entrepreneurs.

Home and Agriculture Affairs Adviser Lt Gen (retd) Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said, there is no militant activity in the country now. The Home Adviser said this at a press briefing after visiting the Export Cargo Village and a cold storage of Bangladesh Agriculture Development Corporation (BADC) at Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport yesterday.

His remarks came in response to recent media reports that several Bangladeshi nationals had been detained in Malaysia and later deported over alleged links to the Islamic State. The Malaysian inspector general of police reportedly alleged that the suspects were collecting funds for IS activities in Bangladesh. Regarding the matter the Adviser said, it is under verification.

Education Adviser Prof. Chowdhury Rafiqul Abrar said, the country's universities, like many other institutions, were on the margin of losing uniqueness due to the 15-year fascist regime. The Adviser said this while addressing a discussion at Rajshahi University (RU) in Rajshahi yesterday as chief guest. RU organized the discussion at its senate building to mark the celebration of its 72nd founding anniversary.

Youth and Sports Adviser Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuyain has strongly criticized the 'unbridled and unbelievable looting' carried out under state patronage during the Awami League regime. The Adviser said this in a post on his verified Facebook Page yesterday.

Fisheries and Livestock Adviser Farida Akhter underscored the need for reinforcing vaccination programme aiming at curbing Foot and Mouth Disease and Lumpy Skin Disease for protecting the health of the livestock of the country. The Adviser said this while exchanging views with different section officials of the Sirajganj district livestock department at the conference room of the Bhagabarighat milk factory in Sirajganj yesterday.

Social Welfare Adviser Sharneen S Murshid said, the nation will long remember the children and women martyred during the student-led July Uprising in 2024 stepped down fascist Sheikh Hasina. The Adviser made the remarks following visits to homes of July martyred Riya Gop, a child who was shot dead in Nayamati and Sumaiya, a housewife killed in the Mizmiji area of Siddhirganj in Narayanganj yesterday. The Adviser further said, the state will ensure the rights of those martyred in the uprising.

Religion Affairs Adviser Dr. AFM Khalid Hossain laid emphasis on making orphans self-reliant so that they can contribute to the country's development. The Adviser said this while speaking as the chief guest at a view-sharing meeting held at Tanzimul Muslimeen Orphanage in Chattogram yesterday.

Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md. Mahfuj Alam expressed profound shock and sorrow at the death of Professor Mahmuda Begum, noted educationist and mother of Amar Desh Editor Mahmudur Rahman. In a message of condolence yesterday, the Adviser prayed for eternal peace of the departed soul and conveyed deep sympathy to the bereaved family members.

The holy Ashura, commemorating the martyrdom of Hazrat Imam Hossain Ibn Ali (RA), the grandson of Prophet Hazrat Muhammad (SM), was observed across the country yesterday with due respect and religious solemnity. Different religious organisations, including Islamic Foundation, took various programmes to observe the day.

The government has published a gazette notification asking 100 people including ousted Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, her sister Sheikh Rehana and son Sajib Wazed Joy to appear before the court to face trial. The gazette was published on July 3. The Public Prosecutor of the Anti-Corruption Commission Mir Ahmed Ali Salam told this to yesterday.

Authorities in India's Gujarat state handed over more than 200 'illegal Bangladeshi immigrants' to Border Security Force outposts located in provinces bordering Bangladesh to send them into the smaller Muslim majority country. The Indian Air Force and other forces made the illegal Bangladeshi immigrants and 'some other undocumented suspects' board an airbus plane at Gujarat's Vadodara airport under heavy security presence, before dropping them off at provinces bordering Bangladesh, reports Indian Express recently.

The Health Department confirmed three new COVID-19 infections in the country over a 24-hour period, according to a statement of the Directorate General of Health Services yesterday.


