Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus called upon the anti-fascist political parties to make more visible the existing unity among them. The Chief Adviser told an emergency meeting with the leaders of four political parties at his official residence Jamuna yesterday. BNP, Jamaat-e-Islami, NCP and Islami Andolon joined the meeting to discuss the recent situation in the country. After the meeting, Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Adviser Prof. Dr Asif Nazrul briefed journalists about the outcome of the meeting.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus has fixed a space at Uttara Sector 12 City Corporation graveyard near the Milestone School and College for burial of those killed in recently aircraft crash. This graveyard will later be preserved to perpetuate their memory, Chief Adviser's Deputy Press Secretary Abul Kalam Azad Mazumder told newsmen yesterday.

The government has postponed higher secondary certificate and equivalent examinations scheduled for July 24, following the crash of a Bangladesh Air Force fighter jet on the premises of Milestone College in Uttara. Education Adviser CR Abrar disclosed the decision during a visit to Milestone School and College campus yesterday. The Adviser also said, a new date for the July 24 exams will be announced once the regular examinations conclude.

Power, Energy and Mineral Resources Adviser Muhammad Fouzul Kabir Khan and Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan yesterday visited the areas affected during a series of clashes and attacks in Gopalganj centering the National Citizen Party march programme. During the visit, they went to Gopalganj District Jail and spoke with prison authorities. They also took information about various issues.

The death toll in the Air Force FT-7 fighter aircraft crash into a Milestone School building in Uttara soared to 31 while the number of injured was 165. The Inter Services Public Relations Directorate disclosed this in a press release yesterday.

The interim government has considered all six demands made by students of Milestone School and College as reasonable, following the tragic crash of a Bangladesh Air Force fighter jet on the campus that resulted in massive casualties. The Chief Adviser's press wing confirmed the media of the matter in a press statement yesterday.

The Bureau of South and Central Asian Affairs at the US Department of State has expressed deep sorrow over the tragic crash of a Bangladesh Air Force training aircraft in the capital's Uttara area. In a post on X, the Bureau stated this yesterday. The message reflects the United States' solidarity with Bangladesh as the country mourns the loss of lives in the incident, while also expressing support for the injured and the bereaved families.

 

Kuwait Embassy in Dhaka yesterday expressed deep condolences and sympathy to Bangladesh following the tragic crash of a BAF aircraft. The Embassy conveyed condolences to the government of Bangladesh and the bereaved families of the victims. The Embassy also said, the Government and the people of Kuwait stand in solidarity with Bangladesh during this time of national mourning and tragedy.

National Consensus Commission Vice-Chairman Professor Ali Riaz said, almost three-fourths of political parties and alliances have agreed that the person holding the post of prime minister will not simultaneously hold the post of party chief. He said this while briefing journalists after the second phase of the discussions of the commission with political parties at Foreign Service Academy in Dhaka yesterday.

Bangladesh Army has started an investigation into some 'unpleasant' incidents that took place during the rescue operations after a fighter jet of Bangladesh air force crashed at the Milestone School and College in the capital's Uttara area recently. Inter Service Public Relation said this in press release yesterday.

Chinese Ambassador to Bangladesh Yao Wen said, China is willing to strengthen exchanges and cooperation with all sectors of Bangladesh, including the military, to help Bangladesh achieve better development. The Ambassador said this while delivering a lecture at the National Defence College of Bangladesh in the capital yesterday.

A Chinese delegation led by Director of the Political Section at the Chinese Embassy in Bangladesh Mr Zhu Jing visited the Teesta River and spoke to people along the riverbanks to assess the feasibility and means of implementation of the Teesta Master Plan (TMP) project. A political exchange of views of BNP leaders with the Chinese delegation was held at the district BNP office in Rangpur with the aim of implementing the nationally and internationally much-discussed TMP project.
