Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus directed the members of the selection board to give emphasis on professional competence, leadership qualities, standards of discipline, honesty, trustworthiness and loyalty, and the overall suitability of the officers for their promotion. Besides, the officers with honesty, integrity and other leadership qualities deserve higher promotion, he added. The Chief Adviser made the directions while inaugurating the 'Army Headquarters Selection Board-2025' at the Army Headquarters in the capital yesterday.

Planning Adviser Wahiduddin Mahmud said, Bangladesh will not be the same again as it was in the previous times. The Adviser said this while addressing a workshop on protection of forest-dependent people from forest destruction, plantation economy, climate change and land grab organized by Society for Environment and Human Development at CIRDAP auditorium in Dhaka yesterday.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd.) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said, no mass arrest has been made over the Gopalganj incident. The Adviser said this while replying to a question from journalists over Gopalganj situation, after coming out of a core committee meeting on law and order at his Ministry in Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

Education Adviser Professor Dr. Chowdhury Rafiqul Abrar said, education-related proposals proposed in the white paper will be taken forward as much as possible. The Adviser told this at a views-exchange programme with the members of the White Paper Preparation Committee and concerned officials at the Ministry conference room. The Adviser also said, the problems identified by the White Paper Preparation Committee after discussing with many stakeholders are certainly acceptable.

Shipping Adviser Brigadier General (R.) Dr. M Sakhawat Hussain said, the government's goal is to modernize and make port management efficient through practical ideas. The Adviser told a seminar on the master plan of Payra Port held in Kuakata in Patuakhali yesterday.

Youth and Sports Adviser Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuyain congratulated the national cricket team for winning the first T-20 match in three-match series against Pakistan. He also congratulated the players, the coach and everyone involved in the board. The Sports Adviser hoped that the winning streak will continue in the remaining matches of the series. The Tigers won the first T-20 match by 7 wickets at the Sher-e-Bangla National Cricket Stadium in Mirpur yesterday.

 

National Consensus Commission Vice-Chairman Professor Dr Ali Riaz said, political parties reached consensus on most of the procedures regarding the appointment of the Chief Adviser of the caretaker government. Dr Riaz said this after conclusion of the commission's second-phase dialogue with political parties, held at the Foreign Service Academy in Dhaka yesterday.

Chief Adviser's Press Wing said, some pro-Awami League propaganda accounts on social media circulated a disturbing video, falsely claiming that the army and NCP-Jamaat jointly carried out a massacre in Gopalganj by dragging patients from hospital beds. The press wing said this in a statement posted on its verified Facebook account - CA Press Wing Facts the day before yesterday.

The Armed Forces of Bangladesh and the United States military will strengthen their longstanding defence partnership this summer through a series of joint military exercises and the introduction of a new capability aimed at enhancing shared security objectives. The US Embassy in Dhaka issued a media note in this regard yesterday.

The much-awaited polls schedule to the Dhaka University Central Students' Union (DUCSU) and residential halls union will be announced on July 29 and the elections is likely to be held in the second week of September. The university syndicate took the decision in a meeting yesterday held at the Nawab Nawab Ali Chowdhury Senate Building on the campus with DUCSU Chief Returning Officer and Professor of Botany Department Dr Mohammad Jasim Uddin the chair.
