Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus yesterday paid glowing tributes to martyred army officers in Pilkhana carnage on National Martyred Army Day. The chief adviser said, 25th February, National Martyred Army Day is being observed for the first time while the current interim government has decided to observe the day as National Martyred Army Day. Every year from now on in memory of all the martyrs in brutal Pilkhana massacre on this day in 2009 will be observed and Bangladesh is committed to ensuring justice for this brutality, The chief adviser added.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus instructed the authorities concerned to launch the 'Hajj Management Centre' to make the Hajj pilgrimage easy, beautiful and safe and to provide round-the-clock services for the pilgrims. The Chief Adviser came up with this instruction at a meeting of the National Committee on Hajj Management at the State Guest House Jamuna in the capital yesterday.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus yesterday expressed deep shock and sorrow at the death of former Minister and valiant Freedom Fighter Abdullah Al Noman. In a condolence message, the Chief Adviser said, Abdullah Al Noman was a talented leader in Bangladesh politics and he was a heroic Freedom Fighter in the great Liberation War in 1971. The Chief Adviser prayed for eternal peace of the departed soul and conveyed deep sympathy to the bereaved family.

The Chief Adviser requested consideration of the government of Maldives for regularisation of the undocumented Bangladeshi expatriates living in the country and to recruit more workforce from Bangladesh. The Chief Adviser conveyed this to High Commissioner of Maldives Shiuneen Rasheed when she called on him at the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka yesterday.

Finance Adviser Dr. Salehuddin Ahmed said that the interim government has been trying its best so that the prices of commodities, especially the essential items, do not increase during the upcoming Holy Month of Ramadan. The Adviser said this while responding to the queries of reporters after chairing two separate meetings on the Advisers Council Committee on Economic Affairs and Government Purchase held at the Cabinet Division Conference Room at Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

Finance Adviser Dr. Salehuddin Ahmed said that it is the main duty of the interim government to lift the economy from the edge of a ditch. The Finance Adviser said this while giving an interview in a recent with BSS. To address the economic crisis, the Finance Adviser emphasized that immediate directives were issued to the Bangladesh Bank, commercial banks, particularly struggling ones and other financial institutions to tighten scrutiny before approving new loans.

Foreign Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain laid emphasis on working together with Moscow to address regional and global challenges and advance the Bangladesh Russia ties as strong as ever. The Adviser made the remarks while speaking at the Event organised in celebration of "50 Years of The Russian House" in Dhaka yesterday.

The interim government's Adviser of the Ministries for Information and Broadcasting, and Post, Telecommunications and ICT, Md. Nahid Islam resigned from his post. The Adviser submitted his resign letter to Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus. At the same time, the Adviser resigned from all the government committees, he added. Nahid Islam said these while briefing reporters in front of the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka yesterday.

Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives and Youth and Sports Adviser Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuyain underscored the need for bringing reforms in personal, political and social life along with the state in the post uprising period. The Adviser told an event on the occasion of the National Local Government Day at the Osmani Memorial Auditorium in the capital yesterday.

Chittagong Hill Tracts Affairs Adviser Supradip Chakma urged the affluent society to come forward to help the disabled persons with special needs so that they would become self-reliant. The Adviser made the call while speaking at the prize distribution ceremony at Khagrachhari Hill District Collectorate Disabled School ground as the chief guest yesterday.

Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam said, the main reason of Elon Musk's Starlink invitation being launched in Bangladesh is to stop the business of online shutdown forever. The Chief Adviser's Press Secretary posted this on his verified Facebook account yesterday.

Home Affairs Ministry said, the claim of rape on a Rajshahi-bound moving bus on the night of February 17 is not true. The Ministry issued a press release in this regard yesterday.
