Newsbrief

Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain said, Bangladesh's youth, who led last year's historic July-August uprising, will ultimately reshape national politics and institutions, moving the country beyond past divisions toward a more constructive, knowledge-driven future. The Adviser said this while speaking as chief guest at the inaugural ceremony of the Bengal Delta Conference 2025, which convened policymakers, academics and experts to deliberate on the intersection of politics, economics and geopolitics in the South Asian region at Hotel InterContinental in the capital yesterday.

Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) AMM Nasir Uddin said, the Election Commission is facing fresh and multifaceted challenges in preparing for the upcoming 13th National Parliamentary Elections. The CEC made the remarks while inaugurating a two-day training programme for core trainers at the Election Training Institute in Agargaon, Dhaka yesterday.

Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam condemned the attack on Gono Odhikar Parishad President Nurul Haque Nur. The Press Secretary wrote this in a Facebook post yesterday. More recently, Nur and his organisation stood with the people during the July uprising, embodying the struggle for democracy, accountability and dignity, the Press Secretary added.

Two Special Assistants to the Chief Adviser Sheikh Moinuddin and Faiz Ahmad Taiyeb e visited injured BUET student Syed Shadid Nasif at Dhaka Medical College Hospital and inquired about his treatment. During the visit, they expressed solidarity with Shadid's family, according to a press release issued by the Chief Adviser's Press Wing yesterday. Shadid, a student of BUET's 2020 batch, is currently receiving treatment at the hospital's emergency unit.

Fifty One Bangladeshi fishermen reportedly abducted by the 'Arakan Army' near the Naf River estuary in Teknaf continues to rise, with multiple sources providing conflicting accounts. Col. Mohammad Mohiuddin Ahmed, Sector Commander of Border Guard Bangladesh Ramu unit told reporters yesterday.

National Board of Revenue (NBR) Chairman and Internal Resources Division (IRD) Secretary Md. Abdur Rahman Khan called for ensuring trade facilitation while strictly enforcing laws to meet the revenue targets for the current fiscal year. The NBR Chief said this while speaking at separate review meetings on revenue collection performance of the Customs, VAT and Income Tax wings for July of the 2025-26 fiscal year.
