Newsbrief

The holy Ashura, commemorating the martyrdom of Hazrat Imam Hossain Ibn Ali (RA), the grandson of Prophet Hazrat Muhammad, is being observed across the country today with due respect and religious solemnity. On the holy Ashura, Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus yesterday issued a message, paying deep respect to Hazrat Imam Hossain (RA) and other martyrs of Karbala. The Chief Adviser said, Islam is a religion of truth, justice and peace. While upholding this great ideal of Islam, Hazrat Imam Hussain (RA), his family members and close companions were martyred in the desert of Karbala on 10th Muharram by the soldiers of the traitor Yazid, he added.

Finance Adviser Salehuddin Ahmed said that the government is committed to returning money to depositors. The Adviser said this following a meeting with government officials at the Nabinagar Upazila auditorium under Brahmanbaria district yesterday. Referring to the state of the banking sector the Adviser said, the Bangladesh Bank is attempting to rehabilitate banks that are in trouble. The Adviser further said that the government is trying to simplify the investment process for foreign investors.

Food Adviser Ali Imam Majumder said, the government is working sincerely to break the syndicate in the rice market. The Adviser said this while speaking at a view-exchange meeting held at the Jashore circuit house conference room on the collection, stock and price situation of food grains in Khulna division yesterday.

Fisheries and Livestock Adviser Farida Akhter has underscored the urgent need for a national policy to determine fair milk prices as part of efforts to ensure the sustainable development of the country's livestock and dairy sector. The Adviser said this at a small farmers' gathering and exchange meeting held at the Potajia Dairy Producer Group under the Livestock and Dairy Development Project in Potajia village of Shahjadpur upazila of Sirajganj yesterday.

Chittagong Hill Tracts Affairs Adviser Supradip Chakma emphasized the cultural and spiritual significance of the Hill Fruit Fair, calling it more than a mere commercial venture. The Adviser said this while speaking as the chief guest at the closing ceremony of the five-day Hill Organic Fruit Fair, held at the Chittagong Hill Tracts Complex in the capital yesterday.

Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam said, journalism of the last 15 years during the Awami League regime will be investigated under the supervision of the United Nations. He made these remarks while speaking as the chief guest at the Media Reform Commission report review event organized by the Broadcast Journalist Center at the Daily Star Bhaban in the capital yesterday.

Attorney General Md. Asaduzzaman said, the people who will be convicted by the International Crimes Tribunal are ineligible to contest any election in the country in future. The Attorney General said this while addressing a programme in Dhaka yesterday.

The widely circulated claim that Chief Adviser Prof. Muhammad Yunus stated the next election would be conducted under the Proportional Representation (PR) system is false, the Chief Adviser's Press Wing said yesterday. No such statement has been made by the Chief Adviser, said the press wing, stressing that the claim is entirely baseless, falsely using his name to spread misinformation. While the PR electoral system has been a topic of discussion among political parties in the Consensus Commission dialogue, no final decision has been reached on its adoption.

The Ministry of Information and Broadcasting yesterday strongly protested a report published by Bangladesh Pratidin on July 4, 2025, captioned 'Film grants are shared among themselves (Chalachitra Onudan, 'Nijeder Moddhei VagBatoyara).' In an official statement yesterday, the Ministry affirmed that the selection of films for grants was conducted in accordance with the Government Grants for Full-length and Short-length Film Production Policy, 2025.

Dhaka will cooperate with the Malaysia in terror investigation while Bangladesh mission in Kuala Lumpur is in close communication with the relevant authorities regarding the issue, according to the Foreign Ministry yesterday. On June 27, Malaysia's Home Minister Datuk Seri Saifuddin Nasution Ismail informed that 36 Bangladeshi nationals had been detained in Malaysia over alleged direct links with an extremist militant group.

Depositions against the ousted Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina for her alleged involvement in crime against humanity during the July-August mass uprising last year will begin at the end of this month or the first week of next month. Prosecutor Gazi M H Tamim said this to journalists yesterday.

A total of 294 new dengue cases were reported across the country in 24 hours till Saturday morning, according to the Directorate General of Health Services yesterday.
