**Newsbrief**

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus yesterday thanked Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan for his cooperation in securing the release of renowned Bangladeshi photographer and human rights activist Shahidul Alam and his repatriation from Israel. Referring to Turkish sources, the Chief Adviser's Press Wing said Shahidul Alam left Israel for Türkiye by a flight.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus congratulated María Corina Machado on receiving the 2025 Nobel Peace Prize for her courageous fight for democracy in her beloved Venezuela. The Chief Adviser said this in a greeting message to Machado yesterday. The Chief Adviser also said, Machado has faced oppression with steadfast resolve, never wavering in her commitment to a freer and more just future for her country and her people.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd.) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said, Bangladesh has no religious division and people of every faith are practicing their religious festival and rituals peacefully, reiterating the interim government's commitment to pursue religious harmony in the country. The Adviser made the remarks while speaking as the chief guest at Kathin Chibar Dan Utsab of the Bouddha Community at Bodhinana Meditation Centre in Ashulia of Dhaka yesterday.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change and Water Resources Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan said, the postal department plays a vital role in communication and it must adapt responsibly and work with dedication in keeping pace with the ongoing digital transformation. The Adviser made the remarks while speaking at the closing session of a discussion organized on the occasion of World Post Day at the Postal Directorate's conference room in the capital yesterday. At the same programme, speaking as special guest, Chief Adviser's Special Assistant on the Ministry of Posts, Telecommunications and Information Technology Faiz Ahmad Taiyeb said, efforts are underway to eliminate long-standing inequalities faced by postal employees.

Liberation War Affairs and Disaster Management and Relief Adviser Faruk-e-Azam, Bir Pratik said that the government is constructing disaster shelters to minimize public suffering during natural calamities. The Adviser noted that in the past, many cyclone shelters were built in low-lying and flood-prone areas, making them less effective. The Adviser made the remarks while briefing journalists after visiting under-construction cyclone shelters at Sharafpur and Chatchatia Shibnagar Ferry Ghat in Dumuria upazila of Khulna yesterday.

Fisheries and Livestock Adviser Farida Akhter urged the authorities to include eggs in the national school feeding programme, saying that eggs can play a vital role in combating malnutrition among underprivileged students. The Adviser said this while addressing a discussion at the Krishibid Institution Bangladesh (KIB) in the capital's Farmgate area yesterday, organized by the Department of Livestock Services, the Poultry Industries Central Council and the World's Poultry Science Association, Bangladesh Branch, on the occasion of World Egg Day.

Social Welfare and Women and Children Affairs Adviser Sharmeen S Murshid called for ensuring women's full participation in political party nominations and their mandatory presence at all levels of party leadership. The Adviser said this while addressing a conference, organized by Women's Political Rights Forum, at the Krishibid Institute in the capital yesterday, demanding meaningful representation of women in national politics.

The repatriation was arranged jointly by the Embassy of Bangladesh in Libya, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and the Ministry of Expatriates' Welfare and Overseas Employment, in close cooperation with the Government of Libya and the IOM.
