## Newsbrief

The Advisory Council approved proposals to amend the Election Commission Secretariat Act, 2009 and the Election Officers (Special Provisions) Act, 1991, to ensure free, fair and impartial elections. Proposals to amend several revenue-related laws under the National Board of Revenue were also approved by the Advisory Council. The approvals came at a meeting of the Advisory Council held at the Chief Adviser's Office yesterday in the capital's Tejgaon area with Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus in the chair.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus said, Bangladesh and China will move forward hand in hand to advance their comprehensive strategic cooperative partnership, bringing peace, prosperity and happiness to the people of both countries and the world. The Chief Adviser made the remarks in a video message at a grand reception, hosted by the Chinese Embassy at a hotel in Dhaka on Wednesday, to celebrate the 76th founding anniversary of the People's Republic of China and the 50th anniversary of Bangladesh-China diplomatic ties.

Finance Adviser Dr Salehuddin Ahmed urged all concerned stakeholders and businesses to come forward and join the Bangladesh Single Window and thus taking their desired services in moving forward the country's economy. The Finance Adviser said this while addressing an event of Celebrating Half a Million CLPs, Seminar on Paperless Customs & Conferring 'e-Return Champion Certificate' to the Tax Payers at a hotel in the capital yesterday.

Home Adviser Lt Gen (retd) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said, the RUCSU and CUCSU elections will be held in proper manner. The Adviser said this while speaking to the journalists at his Ministry yesterday after coming out from a meeting about the overall preparations and security arrangements ahead of the RUCSU and CUCSU elections.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan stressed that the initiatives are not merely about tracking climate finance but about aligning national policies, planning, financing and implementation to ensure coordinated climate action. The Adviser stressed this at the first meeting of the Bangladesh Climate Development Partnership Board on Integrated Climate Finance held at the Chief Adviser's Office in the capital, according to a press release yesterday.

Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam said that this year, at the invitation of the Chief Adviser, leaders of political parties will attend the United Nations General Assembly session. The Press Secretary said this while addressing a press briefing at the Foreign Service Academy in the capital yesterday following a meeting of the Advisory Council. The Press Secretary also hoped that a peaceful solution to the political differences would come through the discussions going on between the National Consensus Commission and political parties.

Chief Adviser's Special Assistant on the Ministry of Posts, Telecommunications and Information Technology Faiz Ahmad Taiyeb laid emphasis on inclusive and equitable development initiatives, saying that no one has the right to implement projects that deprive people. The Special Assistant made the remarks while addressing the District Development Coordination Committee meeting as the chief guest at the Deputy Commissioner's conference room in Cumilla yesterday.

Senior Secretary to the Land Ministry ASM Saleh Ahmed said that an integrated 'Bhumi Seba App' would be introduced soon for rendering digitized land services to the people. The Senior Secretary said this while presiding over a seminar on 'Preparation of an Integrated App on Land' at the Land Ministry conference room in the Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

Senior Secretary of the Election Commission (EC) Akhtar Ahmed said, the EC is set to empower expatriate Bangladeshis to cast their votes by post in the upcoming 13th Jatiya Sangsad election. The Senior Secretary revealed this while briefing reporters at the Election Bhaban in the capital's Agargaon yesterday.

The United States and Bangladesh have further advanced their defense and humanitarian partnership through Exercise Pacific Angel 25, a seven-day multilateral programme focusing on humanitarian assistance and disaster response. US Embassy Charg, d'Affaires Ambassador Tracey Ann Jacobson joined senior Bangladesh Armed Forces officials on Tuesday at Zahurul Haque Cantonment in Chattogram to observe the exercise, which underscores the deepening cooperation between the two countries, according to a press release yesterday.

The Amar Ekushey Book Fair 2026 will be held from December 17, 2025 to January 17, 2026. The schedule was finalized at a meeting held at the Shahid Munier Chowdhury Auditorium of Bangla Academy yesterday.

Six more deaths were reported from dengue and 647 more patients were hospitalized in the past 24 hours till Thursday morning, according to the Directorate General of Health Services yesterday.
