## Newsbrief

Vice Chairman of the National Consensus Commission Professor Ali Riaz said, the commission's objective is to formulate a National Charter based on consensus aimed at fully restoring the democracy in Bangladesh. He told this at a dialogue with Jatiyatabadi Samamona Jote at the LD Hall of the National Parliament in the capital yesterday. Referring to the student-led mass uprising in July last year, he said, it had laid the foundation of the national unity, which is essential for the country's progress.

Religious Affairs Adviser Dr. AFM Khalid Hossain yesterday expressed deep shock and sorrow at the death of Sultan Zauq Nadwi, an Islamic scholar, author and the founder of Jamiah Darul Ma'arif Al-Islamia of Chattogram. In a condolence message, the Adviser prayed for the eternal peace of the departed soul of Sultan Zauq Nadwi and conveyed deep sympathy to the bereaved family.

Labour and Employment Adviser Brigadier General (Rtd) Dr. M Sakhawat Hussain said, the government will pay dues of the workers after selling houses, cars and lands of the factory owners, who fled the country following July uprising. Apart from this, he said that he had already talked the matter of issuing red alerts through Interpol against the factory owners to bring them back home who fled the country without paying the dues of the labourers. The Adviser made the remarks while addressing as the chief guest at a shadow cabinet on workers and owners relations to protect the labour rights. Debate for Democracy organized the debate marking the great May Day-2025, according a press release yesterday. The Adviser also blamed the previous criminalization for the failure in the industrial sector.

Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam said, the July movement is not over as the anti-July forces are getting ready to strike. The Press Secretary said this in a statement posted on his verified Facebook account yesterday. He said it is now a battle between two visions of Bangladesh. One aspires to a democratic, free, and progressive nation, while the other is a kleptocratic, dynastic, Chetonazi regime clinging to the ghosts of its corrupt past, he added.

A Bangladesh Biman flight left yesterday for holy city of Medina in Saudi Arabia from Chattogram Shah Amanat International Airport (CSAIA) carrying 419 hajj pilgrims. It was the maiden hajj flight from CSAIA among a total of 17 hajj flights scheduled to operate through Chattogram airport in this year's hajj season, said CSAIA Director Group Captain Sheikh Abdullah Alamgir. City Mayor Dr. Shahadat Hossen was the chief guest at a brief function on occasion of inaugurating hajj flight operations from Chattogram.

The Administrator of Dhaka North City Corporation (DNCC), Mohammad Azaz said that the Dhaka Metropolitan Police, Rajuk and MRT Project will work with DNCC to ease traffic congestion in the city. He said this while visiting the Bikalpa July 36 Expressway at Pragati Sarani yesterday for opening three corridors from the second U-turn to United International University and Rampura via Aftabnagar.


35 more dengue patients were hospitalized across the country in the 24 hours till Saturday morning, according to a press release issued by the Directorate General of Health Services yesterday.
