Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus has reaffirmed his government's commitment to ensuring that the upcoming general election will be free, fair and inclusive. The Chief Adviser made the remarks the day before yesterday during a meeting with visiting British Minister for International Development Baroness Jenny Chapman at the State Guest House Jamuna, a press release from the CA's Press Wing said yesterday. During their discussions, the two leaders also covered a wide range of issues, including the February general election, tackling illegal migration, boosting trade, the Rohingya crisis and enhancing cooperation in the aviation and maritime sectors.

The government has a plan to develop an economic zone at the gas-rich Bhola district as many reputed companies have expressed their desire to set up industries in Bhola. Power, Energy and Mineral Resources Adviser Muhammad Fouzul Kabir Khan, Industries Adviser Adilur Rahman Khan and Commerce Adviser Sk Bashir Uddin made the assurance while attending a view-exchange meeting in Bhola yesterday. Earlier, the three Advisers also visited the land where urea fertilizer factory will be set up through using the natural gas. The government will not provide gas for household purpose, said the power, energy and mineral resources Adviser Muhammad Fouzul Kabir Khan. The Adviser assured that the construction of Bhola-Barishal Bridge will start after conducting feasibility study again.

The government has nominated National Security Adviser (NSA) Dr Khalilur Rahman as the head of Bangladesh delegation to join the 7th NSA-level meeting of the Colombo Security Conclave to be held on November 19 and 20 in New Delhi, India. The government made the decision following an invitation from Indian National Security Adviser Ajit Doval to Dr Rahman to attend the regional forum. The Chief Adviser's Press Wing said this in a press release yesterday.

Attorney General Md. Asaduzzaman said, the leading forces of the July revolution will determine the path of the future Bangladesh. The Attorney General said this while speaking at a discussion and cultural function marking the birth and death anniversary of Poet Golam Mostafa at Manoharpur village of Shailakupa upazila under Jenaidah district yesterday.

The World Trade Organization (WTO), the Geneva-based intergovernmental organization that regulates and facilitates international trade, has affirmed that Bangladesh will continue to receive substantial support and technical assistance as the country prepares for its transition from Least Developed Country (LDC) status in 2026. WTO Deputy Director-General Xiangchen Zhang said this in an online interview with BSS yesterday. The WTO also strengthens trade capacity in developing economies by partnering with other International Organizations, he added.

Twelve platoons of Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) have been continuing its patrolling in the capital city to strengthen security measures and maintain law and order. The government deployed the paramilitary personnel in the capital to maintain law and order amid incidents of vehicle torching by miscreants. Public Relations Officer of the BGB headquarters confirmed it to reporters yesterday.

The government called upon all not to damage gardens inside the National Memorial in Savar on the outskirts of the capital while placing wreaths at the memorial on the occasion of the Victory Day 2025 to be celebrated on December 16, according to an official handout yesterday.
