Newsbrief

Shipping Adviser Brigadier General (Retd.) M Sakhawat Hossain highlighted the importance of appointing a foreign company in Chattogram Port for operational activities. The Adviser said this while inaugurating an international standard chemical shed at Chattogram port yesterday.

The holy Akheri Chahar Shamba will be observed across the country on August 20 marking the recovery of Prophet Hazrat Mohammad (SM) from prolonged illness. The decision was taken at a meeting of the national moon-sighting committee at the conference room of the Islamic Foundation, Baitul Mukarram yesterday with Religious Affairs Adviser Dr. A.F.M. Khalid Hossain in the chair.

Various Diplomatic Missions based in London have expressed profound grief and condolences over the tragic loss of many young lives in the recent air force fighter crash at Milestone School and College in Dhaka. To honor the memory of the victims and express solidarity with their families, a condolence book was opened at the Bangladesh High Commission in London on July 23 and 24. Messages of condolence have been received from a number of countries, including: Saudi Arabia, Turkey, Qatar, India, Pakistan, Brazil, Spain, Sri Lanka, Malta, Honduras, Poland, Hungary, Trinidad and Tobago, Guatemala, Greece, Mexico, Azerbaijan, Colombia, Ghana, Bahrain, Maldives, Togo, and Algeria, according to a message received in Dhaka from London yesterday.

Four to five victims injured in the recent Milestone jet crash are likely to be discharged today as their health condition has shown significant improvement, said Professor Dr. Nasir Uddin, Director of the National Institute of Burn and Plastic Surgery. The Director told journalists during a press briefing at the institute yesterday.

The government has issued the gazette notification of the Voters' List (Amendment) Ordinance 2025. According to the notification, the Election Commission can publish the voters' list before announcement of the polls schedule at any time of the year if necessary. The Legislative and Parliamentary Affairs Division of the Ministry of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs issued the notification on the day before yesterday.

The government has formed a six-member probe commission headed by former Justice Dr. Md. Abu Tarique to investigate into the violence in Gopalganj including attack on different establishments and hampering public security centring a scheduled rally of National Citizen Party on July 16. The probe commission was formed in light with the recommendations of the probe committee formed immediately after the violence in Gopalganj that left at least four people dead and dozens of injured.

The Indian Border Security Force pushed at least 21 individuals into Bangladesh through Nakugaon border in Sherpur yesterday. Receiving information about the push in, members of 39 Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) detained them. Lieutenant Colonel Mehedy Hasan, commanding officer of 39 BGB, said the identifications of the detainees were being investigated. He also said that the BGB members were on alert to prevent any illegal activities at the border area.

Bangladesh Air Force organized special doa mahfil at all its air force bases and officers' mess across the country for eternal peace of the departed souls of all martyrs and sought quick recovery of the injured of the air force fighter jet crash into Milestone School and College on July 21. ISPR issued a press release in this regard yesterday.
