Newsbrief

The Appellate Division of the Supreme Court (SC) said that there was no legal weakness or interference in scrapping five cases against Prof. Dr. Muhammad Yunus by the High Court. Advocate Mustafizur Rahman Khan, Lawyer of Professor Muhammad Yunus, disclosed this observation of the Appellate Division of the Supreme Court to BSS yesterday. A three-member panel of the Supreme Court Headed by Justice Md. Ashfaqu Islam on December 8 rejected the leave to appeal by the government against the High Court orders.

Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain called on Non-Resident Bangladeshis (NRBs) to engage in the politics of their host countries instead of Bangladesh's domestic politics to enhance the nation's global branding and influence. The Adviser said this while inaugurating an NRB conference on Bangladesh branding at a hotel in the capital yesterday. Citing the example of the Indian diaspora, the Adviser said, Indians have achieved significant global influence by securing crucial positions in governments and political bodies in different countries, especially in Western nations. The Foreign Adviser remarked that Bangladesh's political parties are among the largest in the world, with widespread branches across numerous countries.

Primary and Mass Education Adviser Professor Dr. Bidhan Ranjan Roy Poddar said, it is important to ensure basic literacy at the level by any means. The Adviser also said, the government's policy on primary education will be formed based on public opinion. The Adviser told at a workshop on 'Communication and Social Mobilization Action Plan Preparation' as the chief guest at National Primary Education Academy in Mymensingh yesterday.

US Congress invited BNP Acting Chairman Tarique Rahman and two other senior BNP leaders in the 'National Prayer Breakfast' programme in Washington, DC on February 5-6. BNP Secretary General received the invitation letter on January 9, Media cell member of BNP Shairul Kabir Khan confirmed BSS yesterday. Two other BNP leaders invited in the breakfast meeting are Secretary General Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir and Standing Committee Member and Chairperson's Foreign Affairs Advisory Committee Member Amir Khasru Mahmud Chowdhury.

BNP's Acting Chairman and Amra BNP Paribar chief patron Tarique Rahman took the medical treatment responsibility of 14-year-old cancer affected child Mahmudullah bin Jisan, younger brother of Shaheed Abdullah bin Zahid, who was killed during the students-led mass movement. A delegation of 'Amra BNP Paribar' provided medical assistance for Jisan who is undergoing treatment at Kurmitola Hospital in the capital yesterday. Earlier, the organization paid full expenses of his four more chemotherapy treatments.

Bangladesh Bank Governor Dr. Ahsan H. Mansur announced that the interim government will hire foreign lawyers to recover funds siphoned abroad, offering commissions as incentives for retrieving large amounts. The Governor added that compliance with global laws is crucial in these efforts. The Governor made these remarks during the inaugural session of the year-long "Branding Bangladesh" World Conference Series-2025, organised by the Center for Non-Resident Bangladeshis, the event also included the launch of the Bank Remittance Award ceremony at a hotel in the capital yesterday.

Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) will support Bangladesh Forest Department (BFD) in implementing comprehensive forest management utilizing advanced technologies in the country's coastal zone. JICA signed a record of discussion with the Economic Relations Division (ERD), Ministry of Environment, Forest, and Climate Change and BFD for the project titled "Project for Enhancing Coastal Resilience through Technology-based Forest Management", according to a JICA press release yesterday.

Fact checking body Rumor Scanner in an investigation debunked a claim of murder of a Hindu NGO worker named Shukla Dey Tikli in Boalkhali, Chattogram. In a report published on its website yesterday. In fact, an incident of suicide due to the mental stress is being spread as communal killing. In the investigation of the claim, a report published on the website of the electronic media Jamuna Television under the title "Body of a female NGO worker recovered in Chattogram on January 6" was found.

One dengue patient died and 45 others were admitted to various hospitals across the country in the past 24 hours till Saturday morning, according to a press release issued by the Directorate General of Health Services yesterday.
