Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus urged all to come forward to protecting nature aiming to conserve the country's fisheries resources. The Chief Adviser said this while inaugurating the session of the National Fisheries Week-2025 at the Bangladesh-China Friendship Conference Centre in the capital yesterday. Speaking as the chief guest, Professor Yunus said the fish is a gift of nature and it is a gift of Almighty Allah. He stressed bringing the actual fishers under coverage of the social safety net programmes to protect them from financial hardship.

Bangladesh will hold a three-day international stakeholders conference in Cox's Bazar on August 25 before organising a high-level conference on the Rohingya crisis on September 30 in New York on the sidelines of the UN General Assembly. Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus is likely to attend the event as the chief guest. Cox's Bazar Additional Deputy Commissioner Imran Hossain Sajeeb confirmed the matter yesterday.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd.) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said, the interim government has recruited 15,851 police personnel in the past one year. The Adviser said this after coming out of the 12th meeting of the Advisory Council on law and order at his Ministry office in Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday. The government has also recruited 4469 soldiers at Border Guard Bangladesh and 5551 Sepoys in Bangladesh Ansar and VDP in the last one year, the Adviser added.

Health and Family Welfare Adviser Nurjahan Begum laid emphasis on ensuring proper training to the midwives for safe childbirth. The Adviser said, the work on ensuring breastfeeding is not solely the responsibility of the government or the health sector, but also of NGO workers and mosque imams. The Adviser said this while speaking as the chief guest at a workshop marking the 'World Breastfeeding Week-2025' at CIRDAP auditorium in the capital yesterday. The Health, Medical Education and Family Welfare Ministry in collaboration with the Bangladesh Breastfeeding Foundation organized the event.

Religious Affairs Adviser Dr AFM Khalid Hossain said that those who attempt to desecrate or attack places of worship have no religious identity; rather, they can only be termed as criminals. The Adviser said this while addressing as chief guest a workshop on 'The Role of Temple-Based Child and Mass Education in Achieving Sustainable Development Goals and Disseminating Moral Education' at Primary Teachers Training Institute auditorium in Chattogram yesterday.

Senior Secretary of the EC Akhtar Ahmed said, the Election Commission (EC) will announce the action plan or roadmap of the upcoming 13th national parliamentary election within this week. The Senior Secretary confirmed this while speaking to reporters at the EC office in Agargaon area yesterday.

The Election Commission (EC) will begin hearings on objections and suggestions regarding the re-demarcation of parliamentary constituencies for the upcoming 13th National Parliament elections from August 24. According to an EC notification issued yesterday, the hearings will continue until August 27 at the Commission's headquarters in the capital's Agargaon. Chief Election Commissioner AMM Nasir Uddin will preside over the hearings.



The government decided to bring under three Bangladesh Railway (BR)-run hospitals in Dhaka, Rajshahi and Syedpur under joint management of health services and Bangladesh Railway, an official statement said. It also said, the decision was taken in a tripartite meeting of Health Services Division, Railways Ministry and Finance Division at Kamalapur Railway Rest House in the capital yesterday.

Islami Andolan Bangladesh (IAB) Amir Mufti Syed Muhammad Rezaul Karim said, people of Bangladesh always extended their support to 'Independent Palestine' and it will continue in future. The IAB Amir said this as Palestinian Ambassador in Dhaka Yusuf SY Ramadan paid a courtesy call on him at the IAB central office at Paltan in the capital yesterday.

The interim government has decided to withdraw 16,429 politically motivated and false cases, according to an official announcement posted on the Chief Adviser GOB Facebook page yesterday.

The government has achieved a record-breaking milestone in the domestic Boro procurement programme 2025, which concluded on August 15. The procurement targets were set at 3.50 lakh tonnes of paddy, 14 lakh tonnes of parboiled rice, and 50,000 tonnes of atap rice, according to a press release issued yesterday.
