Newsbrief

The World Accreditation Day 2025 is being observed in the country like elsewhere in the world today. Press Information Department said this in a handout. On the day, Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus gave a message and said, the current interim government formed through the July mass uprising is very sincere in the development of medium and small industries in the country. The Chief Adviser hoped wishing success of the day and extending his greetings to all stakeholders.

Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives Adviser Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuiyan said, the extensive cleanliness drive in the capital Dhaka was completed in less than 12 hours with coordinated efforts. The Adviser made the remarks in a post on his verified Facebook yesterday. Earlier, the Adviser participated in the cleaning programme of the two city corporations of Dhaka.

Commerce Adviser Sk. Bashir Uddin said that the rawhides of the sacrificial animals are being sold in the country at government fixed price. Besides, a special team of the Ministry of Commerce has been working to make effective the government fixed price of rawhides. The Commerce Adviser said this after visiting the operations of fair management of rawhides of sacrificial animals at Posta under Lalbagh area of the capital yesterday. Replying to a question on the seasonal rawhides trader, the Adviser said that most of the seasonal rawhides traders lack due experiences and knowledge in preservation of rawhides and to some extent they are getting lesser prices of rawhides due to bad condition of rawhides. But, they are getting fair prices of rawhides with better condition ranging between Taka 1,200 to Taka 1,300.

Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam yesterday said, the interim government has not received any letter from Tulip Siddiq, reportedly seeking a meeting with Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus during his official visit to the United Kingdom. Alam told UNB when enquired about Tulip Siddiq's reported letter seeking audience with Professor Muhammad Yunus.

The Ministry of Railways has asked passengers to wear masks and follow health guidelines on their return journey by train after the holy Eid-ul-Azha. In the context of the recent rise in COVID-19 infection, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has requested all to wear masks in crowded areas. Especially, the elderly and sick people have been advised to avoid public gatherings, according to a press release yesterday.

The Khulna City Corporation (KCC) workers have fully cleaned the wastage of sacrificial animals within 8 hours after Eid celebration. The KCC also said, over 850 workers had been engaged to remove the leftovers in the city on Eid day. The KCC said this in a handout yesterday.

Dhaka Metropolitan Police (DMP) has imposed a ban on rallies, processions, demonstrations and gatherings in front of Secretariat and Chief Adviser's residence and its adjacent areas including Hotel Intercontinental, Kakrail Mosque intersection, Mintu Road and Officer's Club. The ban was imposed for the sake of the security of the Chief Adviser. The restriction effective from today will remain in place until further notice, according to a public notification issued by DMP Commissioner SM Sazzat Ali yesterday.
