Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus directed the National Cyber Security Agency to ensure all types of cyber security ahead of the upcoming parliamentary elections and the referendum. The Chief Adviser, also Chairman of the National Cyber Security Council, gave the directives while presiding over a meeting of the Council at the State Guest House Jamuna, according to the Chief Adviser's Press Wing said yesterday.

Pakistan High Commissioner to Bangladesh Imran Haider paid a courtesy call on Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus at the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka yesterday. During the meeting, both sides discussed ways to expand cooperation in trade, investment and aviation, as well as scaling up cultural, educational and medical exchanges to further strengthen bilateral relations between the two South Asian nations, said the Chief Adviser's Press Wing yesterday.

Justice Zubayer Rahman Chowdhury of the Appellate Division of the Supreme Court was sworn in as the 26th Chief Justice of Bangladesh. President administered the oath of office during a ceremony at Durbar Hall of the Bangabhaban in Dhaka yesterday. Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus witnessed the ceremony. Advisers to the interim government, judges, chiefs of the three services and Supreme Court (SC) lawyers were present at the ceremony and Cabinet Secretary Dr. Sheikh Abdur Rashid conducted the oath-taking ceremony.

Home Adviser Lt Gen (retd) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said, the government will soon make public the names and addresses of all those involved in the murder of Inqilab Mancha Spokesperson and frontline fighter Shaheed Sharif Osman Bin Hadi. The Adviser said this after attending a Core Committee meeting on law and order at the Home Ministry in the Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday. The Home Adviser also expressed hope that the Hadi murder trial would be completed within the tenure of the current interim government.

Education Adviser Professor Dr. Chowdhury Rafiqul Abrar said, the government has made every effort to provide quality and accurate textbooks to students. The Adviser said this while inaugurating the programme titled 'Uploading of soft copies of textbooks for the 2026 academic year to the website' in the capital yesterday. The Adviser also said, the Ministry of Education and the National Curriculum and Textbook Board held several meetings on ensuring the accuracy and quality of textbooks for students.

Social Welfare and Women and Children Affairs Adviser Sharmeen S Murshid said, the sacrifice and steadfastness of youths are the main force for change. The Adviser made the remarks while speaking at the second convocation 2025 of Sonargaon University held at the International Convention City Bashundhara in Dhaka yesterday. Dedicating her speech to the memory of Sharif Osman Hadi the Adviser also said, Hadi was a great hero of the 2024 mass uprising.


The Election Commission (EC) has asked the Local Government Division to repair or renovate institutions or facilities used as polling centres, install or renovate CCTV cameras and repair broken and narrow roads leading to polling centres before the 13th parliamentary elections and referendum, slated for February 12, 2026. In this regard, a letter was sent to the Secretary of the Local Government Division yesterday.

Shipping and Labour and Employment Adviser Brigadier General (Retd) Dr. M. Sakhawat Hossain said that the government is determined to take strict legal action against those involved in the attack, vandalism and arson at the offices of Prothom Alo and The Daily Star. The Adviser made the remarks while visiting the offices of the two leading national dailies in Dhaka yesterday.

Newly appointed Chief Justice Zubayer Rahman Chowdhury paid glowing tributes to the martyrs of Bangladesh's 1971 Great Liberation War at the National Martyrs' Memorial in Savar yesterday. Flanked by Justice Md. Rezaul Haque, Justice SM Emdadul Hoque, Justice Farah Mahbub and officials of the Supreme Court, the Chief Justice placed wreaths at the memorial and observed a moment of silence in honour of those who sacrificed their lives for the country's independence. The Chief Justice later signed the inspection book at the National Martyrs' Memorial.

Bangladesh rejected the recent comments made by the Spokesperson of the Indian Ministry of External Affairs regarding the situation of the minority communities in Bangladesh. Foreign Ministry's Spokesperson and Director General of Public Diplomacy Wing S M Mahbubul Alam told reporters at the Ministry yesterday.

The Dhaka Metropolitan Police (DMP) expressed hope that the Indian government will extend full cooperation in arresting all individuals involved in the murder of Inquilab Mancha Spokesperson Shaheed Sharif Osman bin Hadi and ensure their repatriation to Bangladesh to face justice. In a statement, the DMP clarified information shared at a press briefing yesterday regarding reports of the arrest of two Indian nationals in Meghalaya for allegedly assisting the prime suspects - Faisal Karim Masud and Alamgir Shaikh - in fleeing to India after the killing.
