Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus said, all political parties and stakeholders have agreed to make the proclamation of the July Revolution. The Chief Adviser reiterated that the interim government would take the nation forward through unity. The Chief Adviser said this while delivering his concluding speech at a meeting at the Foreign Service Academy in Dhaka yesterday. The main thing is that the original spirit of the July revolution should not be lost, the Chief Adviser added.

Chief Adviser Professor Mohammad Yunus will attend the annual meeting of the World Economic Forum in Davos, Switzerland on January 21-24. Foreign Ministry Spokesman Mohammad Rafiqul Alam said this in his weekly briefing at the Foreign Ministry in Dhaka yesterday. Bangladesh's Ambassador to the United States Asad Alam Siam will attend the inauguration of President-elect Donald Trump on January 20, the Spokesman added.

The Police Reform Commission (PRC) submitted its report to Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus proposing amendment and replacement of 22 existing laws for making the “people’s friendly” the country’s main law enforcement agency. The PRC Chairman and former Home Secretary Safar Raz Hossain said this while presenting the report to the Chief Adviser at his office in Dhaka yesterday.

Finance Adviser Dr. Salehuddin Ahmed said, the government is reviewing the issue of VAT rates, increased recently on some essential items and sectors like medicine and restaurants, as those affect the common people. The Finance Adviser said this while replying to the queries of reporters after chairing two separate meetings on the Advisers Council Committee meeting on Economic Affairs and Government Purchase held at the Cabinet Division Conference Room at Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

Law Adviser Dr. Asif Nazrul said, all political parties have reached a consensus on an inclusive 'July Proclamation' acknowledging the contribution of all parties to the July mass uprising. The Adviser made the remarks while talking to reporters after an all-party meeting with the Chief Adviser on the July Proclamation at the Foreign Service Academy in Dhaka yesterday. A plan of action will be taken for preparing the July Proclamation based on the consensus, the Adviser added.

Chinese Ambassador to Bangladesh Yao Wen yesterday met Foreign Secretary (FS) Md. Jashim Uddin ahead of the Foreign Adviser (FA) Touhid Hossain’s visit to China scheduled for 20–24 January 2025. The meeting, held at Foreign Ministry, mainly highlighted the preparation of Foreign Adviser’s visit on both sides, according to a Foreign Ministry press release yesterday.

BNP standing committee member Salahuddin Ahmed urged all to remain alert so that the unity created against fascism is not rifted and any confusion is not created centering the ‘July proclamation’. The BNP standing committee member made the call while talking to journalists after emerging from an all-party meeting with the Chief Adviser at the Foreign Service Academy in the capital yesterday.

Lutfozzaman Babar, former State Minister for Home Affairs under the BNP-Jamaat alliance government was released from the jail yesterday after 17 years, as former State Minister was cleared of every charge that include 10-truck arms haul case and August 21, 2004 grenade attack cases by the apex court.

US Ambassador to India Eric Garcetti said, both India and the US want to see democracy and elections in Bangladesh as soon as possible which will ultimately help Bangladesh open its next chapter. The US Ambassador to India told WION, an Indian news channel, in an exclusive interview recently.
