Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus reaffirmed his government's unwavering commitment to combating terrorism, declaring that Bangladesh will not allow any terrorist group to operate within its borders. The Chief Adviser made these remarks during a meeting with US Charge d'affaires Tracey Ann Jacobson at the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka yesterday. During the meeting, they also discussed matters of mutual interest, including the ongoing tariff negotiations between Bangladesh and the United States.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus said, doctors who performed their duties in July are not just doctors they are also heroes of the July mass uprising. The Chief Adviser said this in a video message to the health workers at the July commemoration programme for health workers serving the injured July fighters at Shaheed Abu Sayeed Convention Center in Dhaka yesterday.

A review meeting on the law and order situation and the preparations of law enforcement agencies for the upcoming national elections was held, emphasising on increasing coordination among the police, army and civil administration. The meeting was held at the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka with Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus in the chair. Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam said this at a press briefing at the Foreign Service Academy in the capital yesterday. About 1.5 lakh policemen will be trained from September for the upcoming general elections, the Press Secretary added.

Saudi Arabia has invited Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus to attend the ninth edition of the Future Investment Initiative to be held in Riyadh on October 27-30, 2025. The Saudi Ambassador in Dhaka Dr. Abdullah Zafer bin Abiyah handed over the invitation of Saudi Crown Prince and Prime Minister Mohammed bin Salman to the Chief Adviser during a meeting at the State Guest House Jamuna the day before yesterday.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury (Retd.) has reiterated that no extortionist will be spared. The Adviser said this while referring to the action taken against the extortionists at Gulshan. The Adviser was replying this to journalists after coming out of the core committee meeting on law and order at the Home Ministry in Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

Food Adviser Ali Imam Majumder called upon the global community to move towards a sustainable food system, confirming Bangladesh's readiness to work for ensuring a better food future for all. The Adviser said this while addressing at the UN Food System Summit in Addis Ababa, the capital of Ethiopia yesterday.

The Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) has announced that it faces no impediment to investigating specific allegations of illegal wealth acquisition against leaders and members of the Anti-Discrimination Student Movement, several of whom were recently arrested in an extortion case. ACC Director General (Prevention) Md Akhtar Hossain said this in a press briefing at the ACC head office in the capital yesterday.

Information and Broadcasting Secretary Mahbuba Farjana called upon all to discharge responsibilities with honesty, neutrality and courage to repay the debt of July uprising martyrs. The Secretary made this remark while speaking as a special guest at a discussion and prayer session organized by the Mass Communication Department at the auditorium of the Information Building in the capital yesterday, marking the anniversary of the July Mass Uprising.



An expert team from China is likely to arrive in Dhaka to assist in the investigation into the recent plane crash to identify the main reason of the accident. Air Commodore Md. Mizanur Rahman, Chief Coordinator of the Air Force Emergency Coordination Center, said this at a press briefing organized by the Aviation and Aerospace University Bangladesh in the Tejgaon old Airport area yesterday. He also said, on the day of the incident on July 21, the Bangladesh Air Force participated in the rescue operation and a high-level investigation committee was formed on the same day.

A Dammam bound Biman Bangladesh Airlines returned to Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport yesterday after the pilot detected a technical alert related to cabin pressure mid-air, Al Masud Khan, Manager of Public Relations of the national flag carrier said.

Two more people died of dengue and 394 others were admitted to different hospitals across Bangladesh in 24 hours till Monday morning, according to the Directorate General of Health Services yesterday.
