## Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus yesterday returned home after wrapping up his four-day Switzerland visit to join the World Economic Forum (WEF) annual meeting in the Swiss city of Davos. CA's Deputy Press Secretary Apurba Jahangir told BSS.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus hoped that the Bangladesh Customs would play a pioneering role in strengthening the country's economic base and thus building an enriched state coffe. The Chief Adviser said this in a message marking the 'International Customs Day-2025' to be observed today, according to a PID handout yesterday.

Adviser to the Ministry of Power, Energy and Mineral Resources Muhammad Fouzul Kabir Khan said, his ministry has been giving special importance in promoting practices of competition in the sector to ensure energy security in the country. Speaking at a seminar titled "Power and Energy Scenario in Bangladesh: Ensuring Energy Security for Development" organized at Federation of Bangladesh Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FBCCI) Bhaban in the capital's Motijheel area, said a FBCCI press release.

Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md. Nahid Islam offered ziarat at the graves of July mass uprising martyrs in Rayerbazar in Dhaka yesterday. After offering ziarat at the graves, the Adviser talked to the relatives of the martyrs and inquired about their wellbeing. Recalling the contribution of the martyrs, the Adviser said the debt of the martyrs can never be repaid. The Adviser also said, the present interim government will always stand by the martyrs' families.

Adviser to the Interim Government Mahfuj Alam said, the power will be handed over through democratic process after completing the cherished reforms. The Adviser said this while addressing a reception at Ramganj Upazila Government College ground in Lakshmpur yesterday.

Earlier, Adviser to the Interim Government Mahfuj Alam said, the Awami League (AL) in no way would be allowed in the next general election as it might help bring back the fascism in the country's politics. The Adviser said this in a meeting at Hajiganj upazila in Chandpur yesterday.

BNP Chairperson Begum Khaleda Zia went to her son and party's Acting Chairman Tarique Rahman's home after undergoing treatment at London Clinic, UK for 17 days. As her health condition improved considerably, doctors advised her to receive treatment staying at home for the time being. Tarique Rahman took Khaleda Zia to his house on Friday.

Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP) Acting Chairman Tarique Rahman said, the people are the source of BNP's political strength. The BNP Acting Chairman said adding that if BNP gets opportunity to run the state through the people's mandate in future, an 'Education Reform Commission' will be formed on priority basis.

The BNP Acting Chairman made the remarks while virtually addressing the National Teachers' Conference yesterday. Pro-BNP teachers-employees organization Shikkhak-Karmachari Oikya Jote organized the event at the Institution of Engineers, Bangladesh Auditorium marking the 89th birth anniversary of BNP founder Shaheed President Ziaur Rahman and National Teachers' Day.

Sarjis Alam, one of the coordinators of the Anti-Discrimination Student Movement and chief organizer of the Jatiya Nagorik Committee said, deposed Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina and her cohorts are making evil efforts to confuse and divide the people by spreading rumors. The Chief organizer of the Jatiya Nagorik Committee told media personnel this yesterday after Skill Development Youth Summit programme of the month-long Tarunya Utsav at the Rahman Government College ground in Panchagarh.

The reports on a Hindu man killing at Tetultala in Khulna, published by several Indian news outlets, were misleading, Chief Adviser's Press Wing said. The press wing said this in a statement posted on its verified Facebook page - CA Press Wing Facts yesterday. Khulna Metropolitan Police, Additional Police Commissioner Kutub Uddin confirmed that Arnab Kumar Sarkar was killed in Khulna on Friday but the killing was not connected to the victim's religion. It was also not reported as a hate crime by the locals.
