Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus urged Turkey to bring their technology to Bangladesh, invest more, relocate factories, and use Bangladesh's youth forces. The Chief Adviser made the call when a delegation, led by Turkish Trade Minister Prof Dr Omer Bolat, called on him at the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka yesterday. The interim government is working to create work opportunities for the country's youths and sought Turkey's help in this regard.

Earlier, Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus directed the authorities concerned to take immediate steps to resolve the waterlogging problem in Chattogram. The Chief Adviser came up with the directives at a meeting of the Council of Advisers in Dhaka yesterday.

Adviser Mahful Alam said, the proclamation of the July Revolution would be made after reaching a broader consensus in consultations with all stakeholders. The Adviser told this at a press briefing at Foreign Service Academy in Dhaka yesterday.

Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) A M M Nasir Uddin said, the Election Commission (EC) is working earnestly to hold a free, fair and acceptable election. The CEC said this while speaking at a workshop titled 'Challenges and Ways to Overcome the Voter Registration Process' organized by the Election Commission Secretariat's Capacity Building Project on the Use of ICT in the Election Process in Moulvibazar yesterday. The CEC urged EC officials participated in the workshop to refrain from any kind of biasness centring the upcoming elections.

The interim government has so far facilitated advanced medical treatment abroad for 11 individuals injured during the July-August student-led mass uprising while arrangements are underway to send another 28 injured persons for similar care. Foreign Ministry Spokesperson Mohammad Rafiqul Alam said this during the Ministry's weekly media briefing yesterday.
